## Around The Cascade Conference

**College of Idaho** - C of I heads to the postseason for the first time since 2010, meeting Corban on Tuesday...Joe Bolin recorded his first collegiate hat trick in the win over Warner Pacific and leads the team with nine goals.

**Concordia** - Concordia has been shut out just twice this season and both occasions came against the top seeds of the CCC. The Cavs fell to Corban 3-0 in Salem on Oct. 5 and dropped a 1-0 match in overtime against Northwest on Oct. 19. Taking out those two performances, CU has averaged 3.5 goals per match.

**Corban** - For the first time since 1998, Corban will host a home playoff game against No. 4 seed The College of Idaho beginning today at 4:00 p.m. at Sparks Field on the campus of Willamette University. Freshman Kemar Prince, who was named Red Lion Offensive Player of the Week yesterday, registered the first hat trick of his career Saturday in helping the Warriors clinch their first regular season title in 14 years with a 3-2 overtime victory over Northwest. If the Warriors win their semifinal game versus C of I, then Corban will host the championship game on Saturday, November 16th, in Salem.

**Evergreen** - The Geoducks missed out on the postseason this year after falling 1-0 at Northwest Christian but will look to bounce back next season with a number of weapons returning in 2014.

**Northwest** - Josh Guerrero returned to the line-up Saturday to score a goal against Corban. He, along with two other starters, had missed three out of four of the final regular season games. The noon start Tuesday is to insure plenty of daylight for the game since Saturday's games both went into overtime and double overtime.

**Northwest Christian** - The Beacons ended the season with their first-ever win against Evergreen, clinching their second highest CCC win total in school history
