## Around The Cascade Conference

**College of Idaho** - Clinched their eighth-straight Cascade Conference regular-season title with weekend wins over Northwest Christian and Corban...will play host to the CCC Championships final site this weekend, the sixth time C of I has hosted (2006, 2008, 2009, 2011, 2012, 2013).

**Concordia** - Concordia holds identical 21-6 records in the first and second sets of matches this year. The Cavaliers have played five five-setters, going 3-2 in those matches. The Cavs have posted 14 sweeps this season while have been swept just twice this season, once against Biola (Calif.) on Aug. 23 and once against College of Idaho on Oct. 26.

**Corban** - This past weekend concluded Corban's regular season, as the Warriors finished in a tie for 8th place in the final Cascade Collegiate Conference standings.

**Eastern Oregon** - Finished second place in the CCC. 25 Wins this season is the third most wins in school history in one season

**Evergreen** - The Geoducks finished the regular season on a four-match win streak, haven earned wins in five of their last six matches. Senior outside hitter Cassidy Watkins was named CCC Offensive Player of the Week following her final collegiate matches.

**Northwest** - None Provided

**Northwest Christian** - The Beacons finished the regular season in fifth place in the CCC. It was the highest finish in school history and gave NCU their second consecutive post-season appearance.

**Oregon Tech** - None Provided

**Southern Oregon** - Lauren McGowne finished the CCC schedule as the league leader in assists and Nikki Keller and Emma Gasman were 1-2 in attacking average as the Raiders took the No. 4 seed into the conference tourney. They'll take on Northwest Christian to fifth.
