Around The Cascade Conference

College of Idaho - Lady Yotes gauntlet continues - having gone 0-4 vs. Frontier Conference teams (including narrow losses at #5 Westminster and Montana Tech last week)...will play Division II Northwest Nazarene and Division I Boise State in the next eight days.

Concordia - In its season opener, the Concordia women's basketball team fell 81-75 to Simpson University on Sunday. Caitlyn McCutcheon set a new career high in points with 32, nearly tripling her former career best of 12 points.

Corban - Corban is off this week, as the Warriors prepare to take on NCAA Division III member Linfield on Wednesday, November 20th, in McMinnville.

Eastern Oregon - Lost to Northwest Nazarene in Exhibition game last Friday, 83-82. Return to action this weekend when they participate in the Simpson Tournament in Redding, Calif.

Evergreen - After falling to Northwest in their season opener last week, the Geoducks welcome Montana Tech and Pacific Lutheran to CRC Gymnasium this week.

Northwest - NU's women will be going to Redding and playing on Thursday and Friday. The Saturday game with St. Katherine was cancelled when their AD pulled the team out of the tournament. William Jessup was good enough to schedule a Thursday night game with NU in Redding to replace the St. K game.

Northwest Christian - After a difficult weekend that saw the Beacons outscored by an average of 27 points, NCU will have a 17-day layoff before returning to action on November 26 when they play host to Simpson University in their home opener at 5:30 pm.

Oregon Tech - None Provided.

Southern Oregon - Ashley Claussen averaged 13 points, 6.5 rebounds and four steals as the Raiders won two games over the weekend at Arizona Christian. They're 4-0 for the third straight year.
