## Around The Cascade Conference

**College of Idaho** - Coyotes have won six in a row for the first time in five years and are off to their best start since the 2006-07 season...C of I has scored at least 86 points in all eight games and have won all six games by double-digit margins.

**Concordia** - None Provided

**Corban** - Following a pair of cancellations against Northwest Indian College due to transportation issues for the visiting team this week, Corban will have a 10-day break between games before the Warriors return to the hardwood on Tuesday, November 26th, against NCAA Division III member George Fox beginning at 7:30 p.m. in Newberg. Corban is coming off a second place finish at the Carroll Classic over the weekend, as junior Jordan Carter led the Warriors with a combined 34 points in the two games.

**Eastern Oregon** - None Provided

**Evergreen** - The Geoducks play just their second NAIA opponent of the season on Sunday when they welcome Cal Maritime to Olympia.

**Northwest** - The NU Eagle men take on two undefeated teams in Pacific Lutheran and Cal Maritime this week. NU hosts the 2-0 Lutes on Tuesday night and the 6-0 Keelhaulers from Vallejo on Saturday. Cal Maritime has already knocked off two CCC teams in Northwest Christian and OIT. NU defeated PLU and Maritime in last year's meeting in Parkland and Vallejo.

**Northwest Christian** - Coleton Baker scored a career-high and produced the highest single-game point total in over ten years for NCU on Saturday, scoring 36 as the Beacons defeated Multnomah University, 111-73. NCU's stingy defense held the high-scoring Lion attack to a season-low 73 points. MU was averaging 112 points per game coming in. The Beacon's 111 points was their highest scoring output since February of 2004.

**Oregon Tech** - Oregon Tech Head Coach Danny Miles is just 10 wins away from 1000 after a 113-94 win over Multnomah Tuesday Night. The Hustlin' Owls will host William Jessup on Friday and Westminster University on Saturday as part of the Midland Empire Insurance Classic at Danny Miles Court with games being web cast [www.OITsports.com](http://www.OITsports.com).

**Southern Oregon** - The fourth-ranked Raiders were off last week and will pick up the action this week at Oregon Tech's Midland Empire Classic. They'll bring along three players averaging double figures in scoring: Eric Thompson (21.8 ppg), David Sturner (18.5) and Kyle Tedder (13.3).

**Warner Pacific** - It was a rough trip to Las Vegas last week for the Knights, as the team came home with three losses. The WP men made it to the free throw line 99 times total during the three contests, but could only convert 64 tries for 65% accuracy. Doug Thomas has been the most consistent performer, as the junior is averaging 14.9 points per game.
