Around The Cascade Conference

College of Idaho - Lady Yotes travel to Division I Boise State on Wednesday in their second of three exhibition games this season, before opening the home schedule on Friday vs. Montana Western – their fifth-straight NAIA Division I opponent.

Concordia - None Provided.

Corban - Coming off a 11-day layoff, Corban finally returns to the court this week with three games against D-III Linfield, San Diego Christian, and Cal State San Marcos. The Warriors will take on Linfield on Wednesday, Nov. 20th, before taking part in this weekend's TCSA/DAP Hoops Classic hosted by Simpson University in Redding, California against a pair of Southern California schools. Junior Tara Vanweerdhuizen is a mere six blocked shots away from breaking the program's all-time career record surpassing former Warrior player and associate head coach Rosey Ball.

Eastern Oregon - None Provided

Evergreen - Picking up a win on Friday against Pacific Lutheran, the Geoducks look to continue their win streak against Northwest Conference schools as they travel to Linfield on Friday before hosting Lewis & Clark on Saturday. Evergreen then travels to Pacific (Ore.) on Tuesday.

Northwest - The Eagles head to Lacey this Saturday night for a non-conference meeting with St. Martin's. The two teams will meet again in the Lynda Goodrich Tournament hosted by Western Washington in Bellingham on November 29. Coach Ken Crawford lives in Bellingham and has coached at Bellingham High and Skagit Valley CC.

Northwest Christian - After a difficult weekend that saw the Beacons outscored by an average of 27 points, NCU will continue a 17-day layoff before returning to action on November 26 when they play host to Simpson University in their home opener at 5:30 pm.

Oregon Tech - The Lady Owls, the last unbeaten team in the CCC will take a 5-0 record into the Midland Empire Insurance Classic this weekend when it hosts Cal-Maritime on Friday and William Jessup on Saturday.

Southern Oregon - The Raiders head to Oregon Tech's Midland Empire Classic this week coming off a split at last weekend's Lewis-Clark State Tournament, where they got a breakout performance out of Kristen Schoenherr. The sophomore guard led SOU in scoring both nights, averaging 20.5 points, while Carly Meister put up 16 points and a career-high 15 rebounds in a 77-60 win against Cal State San Marcos.

Warner Pacific - The Knights will try to rebound from a pair of losses at the LC State tournament versus Willamette on Friday the 22nd. Janelle Weiss was named to the All-Tournament Team in Lewiston.
