Around The Cascade Conference

College of Idaho - Coyotes have won seven games in a row – their longest win streak since the 2003-04 season (last year they won the CCC title)...C of I is 5-2 this season against either NCAA Division II or NAIA Division I teams...will play three more Frontier Conference teams this week (Lewis-Clark State, Westminster, Montana Tech)

Concordia - The Concordia men's basketball team has won five straight games, including scoring over 100 points in three of its last four games. Concordia has multiple players in the top-10 in the nation as Adam Herman is ranked No. 2 in field goal percentage (0.769) and No. 4 in points per game (25.57). Tyler Velasquez is No. 2 in the nation in assists per game (7.86) and Esvan Middleton is averaging 3.14 steals a game to rank seventh.

Corban - After an 11-day break from competition, Corban returned to the hardwood last night against NCAA Division III member George Fox for its first of three games this week. The Warriors will take part in the third annual Capital City Classic in Monmouth over the weekend where Corban is a combined 3-3 all-time in three appearances. In its opener, Corban will take on cross town rival Willamette on Friday before going head-to-head with three-time defending champions and tournament-host Western Oregon in an exhibition game for the Warriors on Saturday.

Eastern Oregon - Defeated NAIA Division I, Lewis-Clark State College on Friday, Nov. 22, 66-63. EOU returns to action on Dec. 6 when they travel to Evergreen to open up CCC action.

Evergreen - After a hard fought loss to 22nd-ranked Cal Maritime on Sunday, the Geoducks will rest up after a busy November before opening up Cascade Conference play on Dec. 6 at home against Eastern Oregon.

Northwest - The NU men hope to extend their three game win streak when they travel to College Place to play back-to-back games with Walla Walla University on Friday and Saturday. The Eagles and Wolves met last season in Kirkland with NU coming away with the victory.

Northwest Christian - On Monday night, senior Spencer Coleman became the first Beacon player to hit the 20-points/20-rebounds plateau in over two decades. He scored 27 points and 21 rebounds, missing the school rebounding record by one. The last player to cross the 20/20 mark was Mat Sand on December 7, 1990 against Warner Pacific.

Oregon Tech - Hustlin Owls Ranks 2nd in NAIA Division II in 3-Pt Fg Made per Game (12.000) and is 3rd in Assist/Turnover Ratio (1.775)

Southern Oregon - Jeff Bush's stellar play at point guard led the fourth-ranked Raiders to 50-percent shooting and two wins at Oregon Tech's Midland Empire Classic. The senior averaged 11.5 points, 6.5 assists and 5.5 rebounds on 8-for-10 shooting, and on Saturday Eric Thompson helped by erupting for 28 points and nine rebounds. The Raiders have nonconference games against Oregon Tech, New Hope Christian and Southeastern (Fla.) on the slate this week.

Warner Pacific - Ryan Parks set a Warner Pacific record with 11 three point field goals in a 122-65 win over Multnomah University. Doug Thomas leads the team with a 90% accuracy from the free throw line (27 of 30) this season.
