Oregon Tech will be in Ashland as Southern Oregon welcomes Northwest Indian and New Hope Christian for a set of games. Eastern Oregon heads to College of Idaho, where the Mounties and Yotes will be joined by Walla Walla and Puget Sound.

Northwest heads up to Bellingham and will face off against Saint Martin's and Western Washington while Corban remains in the Salem area, taking on Cal Maritime before taking on either Willamette or Western Oregon on Friday.

Around The Cascade Conference

College of Idaho - Lady Yotes host the 14th annual Best Western Caldwell Inn and Suites Lady Yote Classic this weekend – as Eastern Oregon, Puget Sound, and Walla Walla head to Caldwell... C of I has won their own tournament seven different times, with EOU holding five tourney titles.

Concordia - The Concordia women's basketball team has multiple players who are in the top-10 statistical categories in the CCC. Junior Caitlyn McCutcheon is leading the CCC in field goal percentage (.568), fifth in free throw percentage (.826), and sixth in rebounding (9.6), Lexi Campbell is tied for third in 3-point field goals made (2.8) and Kelly Huey leads the conference with 3.3 steals per game.

Corban - Last week, Corban picked up its first two wins of the season with victories over Linfield (77-54) and San Diego Christian (61-52). The Warriors will hit the road this weekend for the fourth annual Capital City Classic in Monmouth, as Corban is a combined 6-2 in four appearances that includes a pair of championships. In its opener on Friday, Corban will take on California Maritime Academy with the winner advancing to the championship game and the loser heading to the consolation finals on Saturday. Junior Tara Vanweerdhuizen broke the school-record for most blocked shots in a career last week, as she surpassed former Warrior player and associate head coach Rosey Ball atop the list. Both Vanweerdhuizen (219 and counting) and Ball (216) are the only two players in school history to register 200-or-more blocked shots in a career.

Eastern Oregon - EOU defeated Walla Walla University, 112-44, on Saturday Nov. 23. The 112 points are the most points scored by EOU this season. EOU returns to action on Friday Nov. 29 when they play Walla Walla University in the Best Western Caldwell Inn and Suites Lady Yote Classic. On Saturday the Mountaineers wrap up the classic by playing University of Puget Sound.

Evergreen - After losing their first two games of the year, the Geoducks have won four straight, including an impressive nine-point win over 17th-ranked Lewis & Clark last Saturday. Evergreen will be idle this weekend before hosting Eastern Oregon on Dec. 6 to open the CCC season.

Northwest - The Eagle women will be in Bellingham for the Lynda Goodrich Classic on Friday and Saturday. NU will face St. Martin's for the second straight week on Friday and then take on the WWU Vikings on Saturday in an exhibition game for the Eagles. First year NU coach, Ken Crawford, lives in Bellingham and has taught and coached at B'ham High and Skagit Valley CC.

Northwest Christian - The Beacons return to action on Tuesday night after a 17-day layoff as they welcome in Simpson University for their home opener. NCU is 17-3 all-time against the Redhawks after winning 75-65 in Redding earlier this season.

Oregon Tech - Lady Owls Rank 2nd in NAIA Division II in Field Goal Pct Defense (0.313), 3rd in Scoring Defense per Game (55.000) 4th in Blocks per Game (4.857) and 5th in Total Rebound Margin (12.429) with Kassi Conditt ranking 5th in NAIA DII in Blocks per Game (2.714) 5th in Total Rebounds per Game (11.429) and 5th in Total Blocks (19)

Southern Oregon - Carly Meister's career weekend culminated in her second CCC player of the week award after a couple SOU wins at Oregon Tech's Midland Empire Classic. The sophomore post averaged 21 points and 15.5 rebounds to help the Raiders overcome the absence of their point guard, Ashley Claussen, who was out with an injury. This weekend the Raiders (7-1) host the Flagship Inn Classic, playing Friday against New Hope Christian and Saturday against Northwest Indian.

Warner Pacific - The Knights managed just 32% shooting in a 74-52 loss on Tuesday at Lewis & Clark. Courtney Walchli is enjoying a good start to her WPC career. The junior is averaging 8.5 points per game and lead the Knights in field goal percentage at 53%.
