Around The Cascade Conference

College of Idaho - Yotes have found their offensive stride, scoring 90-or-more points in 3-of-4 games – equaling the number of 90-point games from their previous 94 contests, dating back to 2009-10

Concordia - After an exhibition game at Seattle Pacific on Oct. 29, Concordia returned to regular-season action with a 99-48 win at Portland Bible College on Nov. 1. Senior Adam Herman, the CCC Preseason Player of the Year, connected on 14-of-15 attempts from the field for 33 points. Herman holds a 26.8 points per game average in four contests so far this season. After an exhibition game at Seattle Pacific on Oct. 29, Concordia returned to regular-season action with a 99-48 win at Portland Bible College on Nov. 1. Senior Adam Herman, the CCC Preseason Player of the Year, connected on 14-of-15 attempts from the field for 33 points. Herman holds a 26.8 points per game average in four contests so far this season.

Corban - Coming off an exhibition loss against NCAA Division I member Oregon State, Corban turns its focus to the regular season with two non-conference games this week against Menlo (Friday), and Simpson (Saturday). Against the Beavers, junior preseason all-conference selection Jordan Carter scored a game-high tying 15 points, while freshman Aaron Withe added eight points off the bench to go along with a team-high eight rebounds by senior Josiah Sebens. The Warriors will look to extend their NAIA-leading 873-game streak with at least one-three pointer made this week, as Corban trails only NCAA Division I member UNLV for the longest streak among four-year schools.

Eastern Oregon - For the fourth straight season the Mountaineers have started the season 4-0. EOU hosts Multnomah University this Friday and Saturday with action starting at 4 p.m.

Evergreen - The Geoducks play host to Northwest on Wednesday evening in a rare non-conference tilt between CCC schools before heading out to the Mountain Time Zone for exhibitions against Utah on Friday and Idaho State on Saturday. The game against Utah will be broadcast on the Pac-12 Network in selected markets.

Northwest - The Eagle men take a short trip to play Evergreen in a non-conference game on Wednesday night at 8 p.m. and then take a short break from games as they prepare for a road trip to northern California where they will face William Jessup in a two game series on November 15 & 16.

Northwest Christian - NCU outscored Portland State, 50-39 in the second half of an exhibition game on Friday night, but couldn't come back from an early deficit as they lost 85-73. Coleton Baker led the way for NCU with 35 points, scoring 23 in the second half. Baker averaged just under 30 ppg during the pre-season. The Beacons will open the regular season on Wednesday night against Simpson University (0-1). NCU is 13-2 all-time against the Red Hawks and have won six straight in the series.

Oregon Tech - None Provided

Southern Oregon - The fourth-ranked Raiders averaged 108 points in their first two games -- both easy wins against Pacific Union and Simpson -- and Kyle Tedder hit six first-half 3-pointers on Monday to break Ryan Harbert's SOU record of 220 for his career. David Sturner averaged 21.5 points and 13 rebounds and Eric Thompson posted 23 points and 8.5 rebounds. SOU heads south to play Westmont and The Master's this weekend.

Warner Pacific - The Warner Pacific men off to a 2-2 start to the 2013-14 season, and are ranked #12 in the latest NAIA Div. II poll.
