Around The Cascade Conference

College of Idaho - Coyotes gunning for their first postseason berth since 2010 – needing a win over Warner Pacific and an Evergreen loss at Northwest Christian to earn the berth

Concordia - Senior Septi Danciu set the Cavalier career scoring record with two goals against Warner Pacific last Saturday. Danciu now has 53 career scores and 33 assists in 74 career games. Danciu is second all-time in total points behind former Cavalier Jarkko Tuominen's 160 points (50 goals, 60 assists).

Corban - This week is a big one for Corban, as the Warriors are looking to capture their first regular season Cascade Collegiate Conference crown since 1997. A win versus Northwest on Saturday would secure the regular season title for the Warriors, as well as the No. 1 seed in the upcoming CCC Championships presented by U.S. Bank. Freshman goalkeeper Jordan Farr became the second player in the CCC to register 10-or-more shutouts in a single season since 2000 joining former Concordia keeper Garrett Staples (10 in 2007), as the first-year Warrior registered Nos. 9 & 10 this past weekend against The College of Idaho and Oregon Tech and dropped his conference-leading Goals Against Average (GAA) to 0.49. In his first season at Corban, Farr ranks in a three-way tie for 1st in the NAIA in shutouts and sits in a two-way tie for second in GAA.

Evergreen - Evergreen heads down to Springfield, Ore. on Saturday, hoping to secure the fourth seed in the 2013 Cascade Conference Men's Soccer Championship presented by U.S. Bank. Win a win over Northwest Christian, the Geoducks are in the postseason. A loss or a tie can still get Evergreen in depending on the result of the Warner Pacific at College of Idaho match, also on Saturday.

Northwest - The NU men will face Corban in Kirkland for a game this Saturday which will decide the CCC championship. The Eagles have posted their best record since joining the CCC with a 12-4 overall mark to date.

Northwest Christian - The Beacons will end their season this Saturday against Evergreen. NCU is looking for their first-ever victory against the Geoducks, who own a 10-0-2 record in the all-time series after a 1-0 loss in Olympia earlier this season. The Beacons will honor seniors Erik Carrazco, Austin Crook, and Sam Eymann before the game.

Oregon Tech - None Provided.

Warner Pacific - The Knights wrap up a difficult season this weekend with a trip to College of Idaho. With his penalty kick conversion last week versus Concordia, Jameson Jones has 23 career goals.
