LA GRANDE, Ore. - The six teams that will participate in the 2013 Cascade Conference Volleyball Championship presented by U.S. Bank have been determined but plenty is still on the line this weekend as seeding and host sites will be determined by Saturday.

Two non-playoff teams will meet twice this week as Northwest makes back-to-back trips to Olympia for matches on Thursday and Friday. Corban and Northwest Christian head to College of Idaho and Eastern Oregon as both C of I and EOU will be playing for the top seed.

In Portland, Oregon Tech and Southern Oregon travel to Concordia and Warner Pacific to wrap up the regular season as both SOU and CU will be trying to earn a first-round bye.

Around The Cascade Conference

College of Idaho - C of I completed a sweep of the Oregon Tech-Southern Oregon road trip for just the fourth time in the over 30 year history of the program and swept the trip for back-to-back seasons...Lady Yotes climbed to #23 in the latest Tachikara-NAIA Top-25 Poll

Concordia - With 19 wins, Concordia stands one win away from reaching the 20-win plateau for the first time since 2002 when the team went 24-3 on the season. Concordia's six losses this season all came while facing a team currently ranked inside the NAIA Coaches' Top-25 Poll. CU defeated has won Vanguard (Calif.), currently ranked No. 10 in the NAIA, by a 3-1 margin on Sept. 22.

Corban - Corban will wrap up the 2013 season this week with a pair of road matches at Eastern Oregon and The College of Idaho. The Warriors go into the final weekend of the regular season having won two-of-three matches, including a come-from-behind five-set thriller against Northwest on Saturday. The hitting tandem of senior Olivia Shropshire and junior Claire Bailey have combined to register over 450 kills so far this season, while junior libero Katherine Salness has anchored the Warriors' defense with a team and career-high 416 digs to go along with a team-leading 79 blocks (17 solo, 62 assist) by senior Jenny Harman this season.

Eastern Oregon - In the ninth edition of the Tachikara-NAIA Volleyball Coaches' Top 25, EOU tumbled 14 spots to No. 24. EOU returns to action this weekend when they host Corban and Northwest Christian in its last home matches of the regular season.

Evergreen - The Geoducks earned a road weekend sweep for the first time in school history by beating both Northwest Christian and Corban in Oregon. Evergreen wraps up the 2013 season this weekend, hosting Northwest for a pair beginning on Thursday. The first match is the rescheduled contest from Sep. 20 when match officials were not present.

Northwest - The Eagles limp into their final two matches this week at Evergreen having played with only eight last weekend due to injury. They had already lost the services of senior OH Molly Boyle who suffered a season ending knee injury three weeks ago.

Northwest Christian - The Beacons head into the final weekend of the regular season looking to make some waves to try and push themselves into the top-four in the Cascade Collegiate Conference to earn a home playoff game. NCU would need a road sweep over The College of Idaho and Eastern Oregon along with help from another team above them dropping a few matches.

Oregon Tech - None Provided

Southern Oregon -The Raiders upset 10th-ranked Eastern on Friday but missed a golden opportunity to move into first-place Saturday when they were defeated by College of Idaho. Paulla Pinheiro, who has double-digit kills in 10 of her last 11 matches, leads them up to Portland where they can at least lock up the No. 3 seed against Warner Pacific and Concordia.

Warner Pacific - The Knights will wrap up a difficult 2013 season (1-14 in CCC play) with home contests versus OIT and SOU. WPC will say goodbye to seniors Kristina Naff and Loren Hernandez.
