Around The Cascade Conference

College of Idaho - Lady Yotes head to Salt Lake City, competing against Westminster and Montana Tech...C of I will play 6-of-8 preseason games against Frontier Conference team

Concordia - Concordia will open its regular season at home against Simpson University (Calif.) on Sunday. The Cavaliers defeated the Red Hawks 82-76 in Redding, Calif., last season.

Corban - After opening the season at the Spokane Challenge hosted by Eastern Oregon University, Corban looks ahead to an exhibition contest against NCAA Division I member Oregon State on Friday in Corvallis. Junior pre-season all-conference selection Tara Vanweerdhuizen averaged a double-double with 18.5 points and 12.5 rebounds per game over the weekend, while also registering a team-high three blocked shots to move within six of breaking the all-time career record in program history. Sophomore Megan Benedict came off the Warriors' bench this week to average 7.5 points per game, while Vanweerdhuizen knocked down a team-high 53.3% (16-of-30) from the field against Great Falls and Montana State-Northern.

Eastern Oregon - EOU has started the season with a 3-1 overall record. Its lone loss come to MSU-Northern in the Spokane Classic.

Evergreen - The Geoducks officially open up the 2013-14 season on Wednesday night as they host Northwest in a rare non-conference game between CCC schools. The Evergreen and NU men will also play.

Northwest - The NU women, having equaled last year's season win mark at two, will travel to Olympia along with the NU men for a non-conference doubleheader with the Geoducks on Wednesday night. Their game is scheduled for 6 p.m.

Northwest Christian - The Beacons opened up their season with a 1-1 mark in the Southern Oregon University tournament. Junior Point Guard Hannah Frederick averaged 20.5 points per game while shooting 60% from the floor and senior Post Tami Brown averaged a double-double with 15.5 points and 11 rebounds per game.

Oregon Tech - None Provided.

Southern Oregon - The new-look Raiders put six players in double figures in both of their games over the weekend, going 2-0 at the SOU Women's Tip-Off Classic. Sophomore post Carly Meister hauled in conference player of the week honors after averaging 16 points and 8.5 rebounds. The Raiders lost an exhibition Monday at Boise State and will be at Arizona Christian this weekend.

Warner Pacific - The Lady Knights posted a 1-1 record during a trip through Canada. Junior guard Jordan Wilcox has made 7 of her 12 attempts from three point range.
