Around The Cascade Conference

College of Idaho - Lady Yotes finished the season losing their final eight games, recording their worst record since the 2004 season

Concordia - The Cavaliers have allowed just one second-half goal all season and that occurred when CU was already leading Warner Pacific 4-0 on Oct. 12. The Cavs have not been outshot in any of its 17 contests this season.

Corban - For the first time since 2010, Corban is advancing to the postseason where the Warriors will host a quarterfinal game against Oregon Tech today on Warrior Field in Salem. Senior forward Audrey Sullivan became only the second player in program history to score 50-or-more goals in a career thanks to the third hat trick of her career last week against Warner Pacific, while also becoming the sixth Warrior in school history to tally 100-or-more points during their career. Following Corban's win over Warner Pacific, the Warriors have register 10-or-more wins in four straight years compiling a win-loss record of 48-25-3 over that stretch.

Eastern Oregon - With the, 2-0, shutout of College of Idaho on Nov. 2, the Mountaineers recorded its seventh shut-out in one season. This is a program record for most shutouts in a season. For the first time since 2006, EOU has advanced to the CCC Championships. Mauriana Gonzalez has scored a goal in four of the last five games.

Evergreen - The Geoducks wrapped up the 2013 season last weekend with a record of 3-11-0 overall and 2-7-0 in CCC play, just one win out of the postseason.

Northwest - The Eagles earned the #2 seed in the CCC Championships are await the winners of Wednesday's quarterfinals to find out their opponent on Saturday in Kirkland at 1:30 p.m. Val Seid was officially hired as the head coach this week as he had been serving as the team's interim coach.

Northwest Christian - NCU finished the 2013 season in seventh place in the CCC, their second-highest finish in school history. It was an historic year for the Beacons who defeated Oregon Tech for the first time in school history, and came away with a tie against Southern Oregon, breaking a nine-match losing streak. Kristin Fulbright posted the second-lowest Goals Against Average (1.39) in school history.

Oregon Tech - None Provided.

Southern Oregon - Jacquie Galvez had the first one goal/one assist game of her career Thursday in helping the Raiders clinch their fourth straight postseason appearance with a 3-1 win at Evergreen. Saturday's loss at Northwest dropped them to the No. 4 seed, but they'll host Eastern Oregon on Wednesday in an attempt to win their first CCC tournament game since 2008.

Warner Pacific - With a 2-6-1 record in CCC play in 2013, coach Holly Popenuk is pleased with the improvement of the program and is looking forward to more progress next season.
