Around The Cascade Conference

College of Idaho - Josh Wilson's triple double was the first in the CCC since the 2010-11 season (Gage Aker) and the first in C of I history (through box scores researched from 1980-81 to today)...115 points scored by the Yotes over Evergreen their highest total in a CCC counter...Swept rival NNU for first time since 1996.

Concordia - None Provided

Corban - Over the past 26 seasons, Corban has made at least one three-point field goal in a NAIA-record 881 straight games trailing only NCAA Division I member UNLV for the longest active streak among four-year schools with the Running Rebels' streak sitting at 882-and-counting. The Warriors rank third in the Cascade Collegiate Conference so far this season in made three-point field goals per game, as Corban sits behind Oregon Tech (10.58) and Southern Oregon (10.08) at 8.75 made three-pointers per contest. Freshman Caleb Herzberg leads the team with 27 made three-pointers, as the first-year Warrior is knocking down 52.9% (27-of-51) from long distance.

Eastern Oregon - EOU ranks first in the NAIA in Blocks per game (5.8) and Total Rebounds per Game (48.3). Kalvin Johanson ranks second in the NAIA with total 30 blocks on the season. He also ranks third in the nation in Blocks per Game has he averages 2.8 blocks.

Evergreen - The Geoducks stay busy this week, hosting Puget Sound on Wednesday and Lewis-Clark State on Saturday in a pair of non-conference tilts.

Northwest - The Eagle men will head north across the border for the second time this season to take on Quest University in Squamish, B.C., on Saturday in their lone game this weekend. Quest is located south of Whistler and this will be the second meeting between the two teams this season with the Eagles winning at home on Nov. 2.

Northwest Christian - After another strong week, Austin Kuemper moved up to #2 in the Cascade Collegiate Conference in scoring, averaging 21.6 points per game. He is also fourth in the conference in rebounding, averaging 9.9 rebounds per game. Teammate Spencer Coleman is third in the CCC in scoring (21.0 ppg). He also leads the conference and is fourth in the NAIA in rebounding, averaging 11.6 boards per game.

Oregon Tech - Ranks 2nd in NAIA DII in Assist/Turnover Ratio (1.872) and 3rd in total 3-Pt FG Made (127) Head Coach Danny Miles now has 994 career wins.

Southern Oregon - Eric Thompson's strongest season yet was not slowed during the first weekend of CCC play, where he averaged 20 points and 11 rebounds in leading the Raiders to their eighth and ninth straight wins. Thompson shot 15-for-23 and is at 56.6 percent from the field this year. After 12 games last year, he was shooting 44.8 percent (70-for-156). The Raiders shot up one spot to No. 2 in the NAIA rankings for the second straight week and have a home meeting with No. 24 California Maritime on Saturday.

Warner Pacific - Ryan Parks has made 42 three pointers so far this season. If the trend continues, he has a chance to break his own WPC season record of 95 makes set last season.
