## Around The Cascade Conference

**College of Idaho** - Erica Martinez ranks fourth in the NAIA Division II in three-point percentage, trying to become just the fifth C of I player to finish a season with a three-point percentage above 40%...Chakala Carthen had a season-high 16 rebounds at Northwest, recording her sixth double-double of 2013-14

**Concordia** - None provided

**Corban** - Junior Tara Vanweerdhuizen came within one blocked shot of registering the first triple-double of her career, as she tallied 10 points, a career-high 21 rebounds, and nine blocked shots Saturday against rival Northwest Christian. Sophomore Julia Young leads Corban in scoring over the past six games with a total of 93 points (avg. 15.5), as the second-year Warrior began the stretch with a career-high 21 points before bettering that mark Saturday with 24 points against the Beacons.

**Eastern Oregon** - After falling out of the Coaches' Top 25 poll last week, EOU returns to the poll this week as No. 24. Brittney Newcomb ranks in the top five in the nation in three point field goals made per game (3.8) and points per game (22.6). EOU steps out of conference play this weekend for the last time this season, when they play Whitworth and Whitman.

**Evergreen** - The Geoducks look to get back to their winning ways this week, hosting Puget Sound on Wednesday before heading across the mountains to Ellensburg to take on Central Washington in an exhibition on Saturday.

**Northwest** - The NU women will host two non-conference games this Friday and Saturday in Kirkland when they play Pacific Lutheran on Friday and Quest on Saturday. This will be NU's 4th and 5th homes games this season as they were on the road in the first 8 of their 9 games.

**Northwest Christian** - This week the Beacons will play host to Linfield College in a non-conference tilt. NCU is 3-2 all-time against the Wildcats, but have dropped two of the last three meetings. Four of the five games in the series have been decided by four points or less.

**Oregon Tech** - Kassi Conditt reached the 1000 point plateau after finishing up with 11 points on Saturday night. Conditt is now 4th on the Oregon Tech all-time scoring list (1009) and needs just 11 more to move into 3rd. Oregon Tech will next host New Hope Christian this Sunday and Pacific Union College next Tuesday, their last non-conference games of the season.

**Southern Oregon** - Freshman guard Autumn Durand continued to blossom for SOU during the first week of conference action, averaging 19.5 points and 8.5 rebounds with a 14-for-23 shooting clip. The Raiders had no trouble with Concordia or Warner Pacific, winning their sixth and seventh straight games and moving up to No. 17 in the rankings going into Saturday's nonleague contest at Cal Maritime.

**Warner Pacific** - Senior forward Lacy Wood turned in perhaps her best weekend as a Knight, scoring 20 points and grabbing 10 rebounds during the two losses at OIT and SOU.
