## Around The Cascade Conference

**College of Idaho** - Coyotes 79-62 win over Northwest Nazarene last week was the largest victory margin by a C of I at NNU in the history of the series, dating back to 1933 (previous mark was 16 points during the 1952-53 season)... Yotes host #2 Southern Oregon on Saturday, the third time a Top-2 team has played in Caldwell (#1 OIT in 2003, #1 EOU in 2013).

**Concordia** - Concordia has cracked the 100-point plateau in five of its 11 games so far this season and holds a 100.6 points per game average. In its eight wins, the teams scoring jumps to 107.5 points per game while the Cavaliers have been held to just 82.3 points per game in its three losses.

**Corban** - In his first four games this season, sophomore Cyrus Ward is averaging a team-high 17.0 points per game that includes a career-high 33 against NCAA Division III member George Fox this past Saturday. The second-year Warrior is shooting almost 66% (27-of-41) from the field so far this year to lead the team, while also pulling down an average of 7.3 rebounds per contest. Despite making only three shots from beyond the three-point line against the Bruins, Corban extended its NAIA record streak of consecutive games with at least one three-pointer made to 882 in a row and trail only UNLV (883-and-counting) for the longest active streak among four-year schools.

**Eastern Oregon** - Return to action after a week off this weekend when they host SOU and OIT in EOU's conference home opener. EOU ranks first in the NAIA in Defensive rebounds per game (35.1), total rebounds per game (48.3), total rebound margin (14.5) and defensive field goal percentage (36.4). Kalvin Johanson ranks second in the nation in total blocks (30) and third in blocks per game (2.7).

**Evergreen** - The Geoducks will play their fourth NCAA Division I school of the season on Monday afternoon when they head down to Portland to take on Portland State. Earlier this season, Evergreen played at Utah, Idaho State and Seattle.

**Northwest** - After posting their 11th win of the season in Canada on Saturday, the Eagles put their 2-0 CCC record to a test when they travel to Eugene to face NCU and first year coach, Luke Jackson and then on to Salem to take on Corban.

**Northwest Christian** - The Beacons are averaging 77.8 points per game this season, up more than 15 ppg from the 2012-2013 campaign. NCU has already won seven games and needs just three victories to surpass their win total from last year.

**Oregon Tech** - Head Coach Danny Miles is just 6 wins away from 1000 in his career all at Oregon Tech.

**Southern Oregon** - None Provided.

**Warner Pacific** - The Knights resume action after an 11 day break with a trip to New Hope Christian on Wednesday.
