Around The Cascade Conference

College of Idaho - Lady Yotes play host to two Top-20 teams this weekend, as #17 Southern Oregon and #14 Oregon Tech come to Caldwell...C of I had their string of games with at least eight made three-pointers snapped at six (though they hit seven in a loss to #4 Westminster).

Concordia - Nine different players have made at least three starts for Concordia this season. Junior center Caitlin McCutcheon is the lone player to start all 13 contests. McCutcheon is averaging a 'double-double' this season with 13.4 points per game and 10.2 rebounds per game.

Corban - Junior Tara Vanweerdhuizen was named as part of the all-tournament team at this past weekend's KER Classic, as the third-year Warrior averaged 8.5 points and 8.5 rebounds against Whitman and Whitworth. Vanweerdhuizen also registered a combined six blocked shots en route to pushing her career total to 249 in 74 career games (avg. 3.4), which is a school record. So far this season, Vanweerdhuizen is the only player in the conference with over 25 offensive and 100 defensive rebounds, as she leads the conference in total rebounds with 133 and rebounds per game with an average of 11.1 per game.

Eastern Oregon - Brittney Newcomb ranks third in the NAIA in points per game as she averages 23.0. She ranks fourth in made three pointers per game (3.7) and free throw percentage (89.7). EOU has made the sixth most three pointers on the season. The Mountaineers have made 115. EOU went 1-1 last week with a win over Whitworth and were defeated by Whitman.

Evergreen - The Geoducks play their final games of 2013 this weekend as they make the trip to Corban and Northwest Christian for a pair of Cascade Conference games. Evergreen ranked third nationally in rebounds given up per game, allowing just 32.11 rpg on average.

Northwest - NU has already bettered last season's wins (2) as they took two straight over the past weekend with non-conference wins over PLU and Quest to improve to 8-4 on the season. One of NU's two wins last year came against Corban and they dropped both meetings with the Beacons.

Northwest Christian - The Beacons continue Cascade Collegiate Conference action this weekend against Northwest and Evergreen. NU holds a 7-5 lead in the all-time series with NCU after winning both ends of the home-and-home series last year. The Geoducks are 9-5 in the all-time series with the Beacons. Those teams split their pair of games in 2012-2013.

Oregon Tech - At 14-0 the Lady Owls are off to the best start in school history.

Southern Oregon - None Provided

Warner Pacific - WPC fell to 4-8 on the season after a 77-51 loss at home to Whitworth on Tuesday night. Ali Campbell is 8th in the CCC in rebounding at 7.6 per game.
