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Around The Cascade Conference

College of Idaho - Win over SOU was C of I's second all-time win vs. #2 team in NAIA (defeated Siena Heights, 96-88 at the 2001 NAIA Division II National Tournament)...Josh Wilson became just the second player in CCC with three double-digit assist games this season with 11 assists vs. SOU...best start since the 2006-07 season, when Yotes opened 15-3, including a 4-0 record in CCC play.

Concordia - Concordia shot just 37.9 percent against Warner Pacific on Saturday, the lowest rate of the season for the Cavs. Concordia has posted a field goal percentage of 50 percent or better in nine of its previous 12 games prior to the game against the Knights.

Corban - Coming off a pair of wins over Evergreen and nationally-ranked Northwest this past weekend, Corban will take a one-game break from league play taking on New Hope Christian. The Warriors shot a combined 49-of-94 (52.1%) from the field over the weekend, as Corban ranks fourth in the conference in shooting percentage knocking down 48.4% (287-for-593) of its field goals so far this season. Through its first 11 games of the season, Corban's scoring average is up almost eight points per game after averaging 66.6 points per game in 2012-13 compared to 74.4 points per contest in 2013-14.

Eastern Oregon - None Provided

Evergreen - Junior Dre Taylor proved effective in his season debuts, putting up a pair of 20+ point performances in losses at Corban and Northwest Christian. The Seattle native transferred to Evergreen from North Idaho College after play his prep ball at Garfield High School.

Northwest - The NU men will take a week off for the holidays and resume practice next week in preparation for their next conference game with Evergreen in Kirkland on January 4.

Northwest Christian - NCU (9-4) has tied their total number of wins from the entire 2012-2013 season in just 13 games. The Beacons knocked off #17 Northwest on Friday and are now 3-0 in the CCC for the first time in school history.

Oregon Tech - None Provided

Southern Oregon - SOU's 11-game win streak ended Saturday at the hands of College of Idaho, putting the Raiders at 13-2 with a nonleague game up next on Dec. 30 at William Jessup. The Raiders did, however, score the largest margin of victory at Eastern Oregon in 37 years on Friday, 83-60, and Eric Thompson led the team with 20.5 points per game over the weekend. Thompson has now led the Raiders in scoring nine times this season.
