Around The Cascade Conference

College of Idaho - Lady Yotes completed a weekend sweep of nationally ranked OIT and SOU teams...won their 11th-straight home game vs. OIT and their 12th-straight win overall against SOU...of C of I's 12 games this season, five have come against Top-25 teams...Lady Yotes have won 23 of their past 24 home CCC games...Chakala Carthen leads the CCC with eight double-doubles this season, while Erica Martinez became the tenth C of I player to score 30-or-more points in a game with her 30-point effort vs. Southern

Concordia - After a 1-11 start, Concordia won two road matches last week for its first winning streak of the season. Caitlyn McCutcheon is averaging a 'double-double' this season with 13.4 points and 10.1 rebounds per game. Freshman Lexi Campbell has more than half (41 of 74) of the team's 3-pointers this season.

Corban - Following a pair of victories this weekend over Evergreen and Northwest, Corban is one of only two teams in the conference that are unbeaten through the first two weekends of league play this season joining nationally-ranked Eastern Oregon. In its first 14 games of the season, the Warriors are allowing almost nine points per game less than last season as Corban is giving up 62.8 points per game in 2013-14 to rank fourth in the conference compared to 71.0 points per game during its first 14 games of 2012-13.

Eastern Oregon - None Provided

Evergreen - The Geoducks finally broke back into the win column last Saturday at Northwest Christian, using a defensive gem to shut down the Beacons, 70-43. Evergreen remains idle for the rest of 2013, resuming CCC play on Jan. 4 at Northwest.

Northwest - The Eagles will take a brief break for the holiday and then return to practice on the 26th to prepare for a non-conference home game with Whitworth on Sat., Dec. 28. Then, on Jan.3, the Eagles head to College Place to play Walla Walla and come right back home to host Evergreen the next day on Jan 4.

Oregon Tech - None Provided

Southern Oregon - Trips to Eastern Oregon and College of Idaho slowed the Raiders down and ended their eight-game win streak. Carly Meister turned in two more strong games, averaging 17.5 points and 7.5 rebounds, but the problem was on the other end of the floor where SOU gave up 96.5 points per night. They'll next be in action on Dec. 30 at New Hope Christian before returning home for CCC contests against Northwest Christian and Corban.
