Friday will feature 13th-ranked Concordia traveling to third-ranked Southern Oregon in Ashland, Ore.. CU will also play at Oregon Tech this weekend while Warner Pacific will also travel to SOU.

20th-ranked College of Idaho will take on Northwest, among those receiving votes in the latest Top 25, while Eastern Oregon takes on Evergreen before switching locales for Saturday. Corban hosts Northwest Christian in a family affair that will feature Corban's Steve Masten coaching against son-in-law and Northwest Christian head coach Luke Jackson.

Around The Cascade Conference

College of Idaho - Coyotes closed out their preseason schedule with a 9-3 record – their best preseason mark since going 6-1 in 2006-07...C of I played 10-of-12 non-conference games vs. NAIA Division I or NCAA Division II, the other nine teams in the CCC played a combined 12 games vs. NAIA I or NCAA II teams.

Concordia - Concordia cracked the top 25 for the first time in nearly a decade this week. The Cavs were last voting into the top 25 by the coaches on Jan. 13, 2004 with a No. 18 ranking. Ranked No. 13 this week, the Cavs earned its highest ranking since a No. 6 result on Feb. 22, 2000.

Corban - After playing three games last week within a five-day stretch, Corban opens its Cascade Collegiate Conference schedule against rival Northwest Christian Friday. Second-year head coach Steve Masten will draw up plays in the hopes of defeating his son-in-law, NCU's first-year head coach Luke Jackson, in the head coach of the Warriors first return to CCC play since 1998. Junior Jordan Carter enters CCC play with a team-best average of 18.3 points per game, while freshman Caleb Herzberg is averaging 15.0 points per contest off the bench for the Warriors.

Eastern Oregon - EOU returns to action on Dec. 6 as it opens up conference play at The Evergreen State College. EOU has not played a game since, Nov. 22 when they Mountaineers defeated Lewis-Clark State College, 66-63. Eastern Oregon ranks No. 1 in Blocks per game (5.9), Defensive Rebounds per game (36.1), and Total Rebounds per game (48.9).

Evergreen - The Geoducks resume play this week as they host Eastern Oregon and 20th-ranked College of Idaho. Senior Kyle Calhoun ranks third in the CCC in scoring with 21.8 ppg.

Northwest - Northwest (8-2) faces their first test in the CCC as they open conference play against two teams off to great starts this season and both with first-year coaches. The College of Idaho comes in Friday sporting a 9-3 pre-season mark and NU hosts Eastern Oregon on Saturday night who will come into the NU Pavilion of a 8-1 non-conference mark.

Northwest Christian - NCU has increased their scoring from last season by over 17 points per game. After scoring 62 ppg in 2012-2013, the Beacons are now averaging just under 80 ppg. Senior Spencer Coleman leads the conference and is currently #2 in the NAIA in rebounding, averaging 12.6 rpg. He is also second in the CCC in scoring with 22 points per contest. The Beacons will be looking to Coleman to help break a five-game losing streak to Corban on Friday night, when the teams open the conference schedule in Salem.

Oregon Tech - The Hustlin' Owls Rank 2nd in Division II in Total 3-Pt FG Made (106) and 3rd in Assist/Turnover Ratio (1.783)

Southern Oregon - The third-ranked Raiders will streak into conference play with seven straight wins and their highest ranking since the 2005-06 season. David Sturner had four double-doubles in as many games over a seven-day stretch ending with Monday's win at Simpson and is seventh in the nation at 10.8 rebounds per game. SOU leads the NAIA in assists, paced by Jeff Bush's 7.8 per game, and Eric Thompson's 20.6-point scoring average is a team-best.

Warner Pacific - After starting the season with a 4-6 record, the Knights fell out of the NAIA top 25 for the first time since 10/24/2011 ... During the win over Multnomah last week, Ryan Parks set a Warner Pacific record with 11 three pointers made in a single game .
