Around The Cascade Conference

College of Idaho - Lady Yotes take a three-game win streak into CCC play, including winning the title of the Best Western Caldwell Inn and Suites Lady Yote Classic...Chakala Carthen has five double-doubles in the seven games played, with both Elisha Hensey and Erica Martinez have scored in double-figures in 6-of-7 games.

Concordia - Due to injuries, the Cavaliers have had to use five different starting lines ups this year with nine different players recording at least one start. Junior center Caitlyn McCutcheon is the only player to start all nine games for CU this year.

Corban - Head coach Dave Bale returns to Cascade Collegiate Conference play for the first time since Corban captured the CCC Tournament title in 2007 when the Warriors take on rival Northwest Christian Friday in Salem. Capital City Classic all-tournament selections junior Tara Vanweerdhuizen and sophomore Julia Young lead the Warriors this season with averages of 14.6 and 11.4 points per game, respectively, while Vanweerdhuizen is averaging a double-double that includes a team-best 11.0 rebounds per contest.

Eastern Oregon - The Mountaineers went 1-1 in the Best Western Caldwell Inn and Suites Lady Yote Classic. EOU defeated Walla Walla University, 96-34. The Mountaineers lost to University of Puget Sound, 82-77. Eastern Oregon battled back from 17 down to trim the led to two points before falling. Eastern Oregon ranks third in the nation with 91 made three pointers on the season. They are led by Brittney Newcomb, ranks 10th in the NAIA with 26 made three pointers on the season.

Evergreen - Junior Brittany Gray was named Red Lion Player of the Week after scoring 29 points and bringing down 16 rebounds in a win against Pacific (Ore.). The younger sister of former Gonzaga standout Steven Gray, she is averaging 14.3 ppg and 9.2 rpg after redshirting last season.

Northwest - First year Eagle coach, Ken Crawford, begins his first CCC campaign this weekend as the Eagles face the College of Idaho and Eastern Oregon. The Eagles lost both meetings with the Yotes and Mounties last season as they only won 2 of 25 contests. NU has already surpassed last season's record and come into this weekend's game with a 5-3 record.

Northwest Christian - Senior Tami Brown is averaging a double-double this season having already racked up 79 rebounds in seven games. She leads the CCC and is fourth in the NAIA, averaging 11.3 rebounds per game. NCU heads to Salem on Friday to open up CCC action against Corban. The Beacons will look to continue a winning streak against the Warriors as they won both games last season. Corban holds a 13-5 edge all-time.

Oregon Tech - Riding a 10-game win streak to open the season, the Oregon Tech women's basketball team earned their highest-ever ranking in the NAIA Division II Women's Basketball Coaches' Poll, and sit at No. 16.

Southern Oregon - For the first time in four years, the Raiders cracked the NAIA rankings at No. 19 on Tuesday thanks to a 9-1 start that brings them to conference action. The Raiders have had to win their last four games without point guard Ashley Claussen, but she is expected to return this weekend to join a lineup that includes four players scoring in double digits. Carly Meister (15.4 points, 8.7 rebounds) and Kristen Scheonherr (14.8 points, 5.9 rebounds) lead the way.

Warner Pacific - The Knights head into CCC play with a 3-5 record. The team has struggled from the three point line, hitting just 27% from that distance. WP is faring better from the free throw line however, making 68% of their attempts which is #3 in the CCC.
