Cascade Collegiate Conference Notes

LA GRANDE, Ore. - After 18 games, the regular season championship resulted in a split but only one team can win the conference tournament as the 2013 Cascade Conference Men's Basketball Championships starts on Wednesday.

Warner Pacific used a win over Eastern Oregon on Friday night to pull even in the standings and eventually earn a share of the conference title, taking the top seed in the conference tournament on a tiebreaker. The Knights will host Corban in an opening-round game.

EOU is the second seed and will host Oregon Tech to open the postseason. Southern Oregon earned the third seed and the right to host sixth-seed Concordia while fifth-seed Northwest makes the long drive to fourth-seed College of Idaho to round out the first round pairings.
