LA GRANDE, Ore. - Generally considered one of the top small college conferences in the country, the Cascade Collegiate Conference is sending four teams to the 2013 NAIA Division II Men's Basketball Tournament in Port Lookout, Mo.

Eastern Oregon will open up the CCC delegation at the national tournament on Wednesday, March 6 when they take on Midland (Neb.). Southern Oregon will also be in action on Wednesday, playing Madonna (Mich.).

Northwest takes on Dordt when the first round continues on Thursday, March 7. Warner Pacific wraps up the first round on Thursday as well, taking on Dakota State in the first round.

Last season, Oregon Tech brought a national title back to the CCC, defeating Northwood (Fla.).
