Around The Cascade Conference

College of Idaho - Lady Yotes ranked #6 for 7th time (equals highest ranking in program history)...were ranked #6 in 2007 Preseason Poll.

Concordia - Concordia will get several early tests with four matches against ranked opponents at the Biola Summer Slam. The Cavs will face No. 20-ranked CSU San Marcos and No. 29-ranked Vanguard University on Thursday, August 22 and will return to face No. 16 Westmont College and No. 4-ranked Biola on Friday in La Mirada, Calif.

Corban - Corban will open its 2013 season at the Red Lion Cascade/Frontier Challenge with six matches against Frontier Conference members. This is the second year in a row that the Warriors open their season in Spokane, Washington. Head coach Tracy Smith is preparing to embark on her 19th season at the helm of the Warriors, as she is the longest tenured coach currently at Corban.

Eastern Oregon - With the 23-7 record in 2012, EOU compiled the best year in the 45 years of the program, open its season Thursday in the Cascade/Frontier Red Lion Challenge. EOU returns First-Team All-CCC Stefani Sorensen and Casey Loper. Sorensen led the Mountaineers in kills with 318, while Loper followed with 317.

Evergreen - A new era of Geoduck volleyball begins this week as Angela Spoja takes over as head coach. Spoja joins Evergreen after a successful eight-year run at Tacoma Community College. A three-time NWAACC Coach of the Year, she led the Titans to a record of 155-60, including undefeated marks in league in both 2007 and 2010.

Northwest -- Steve Bain begins his second year as head coach of the Eagle volleyball team. This year's team is young, but experienced with only three seniors on the squad. Bain earned his PhD in Veterinary Science from Washington State University and is currently a research associate professor in the Department of Orthopaedics at the University of Washington.

Northwest Christian - The Beacons return a roster almost completely intact from a 2012 squad that qualified for the CCC post-season tournament for the first time. Missing from the team, however, is CCC Newcomer of the Year Tami Brown, an NAIA All-American Honorable Mention selection last season.

Oregon Tech - None Provided

Southern Oregon - Southern Oregon, coming off a 19-11 season, opens with four NAIA Top 25 squads on Thursday and Friday at the Biola Invitational, including No. 1 Concordia and No. 4 Biola (Calif.). The Raiders have 10 returnees in tow but will be welcoming four new starters into the lineup.
