Around The Cascade Conference

College of Idaho - Despite going 0-4 at the Red Lion Summerslam, the Lady Yotes took one set off of every opponent - including three that were nationally ranked.

Concordia - The Concordia Cavaliers volleyball team will host Lewis-Clark State College on Saturday Aug. 31 at Cavalier Court at 7 p.m. The Cavaliers volleyball team opened their season with a big win as they upset No. 20 California State University-San Marcos 3-2 (25-22, 24-26, 21-25, 25-21, 15-13).

Corban - None Provided

Eastern Oregon - Went 5-1 in the Cascade/Frontier Red Lion Challenge, the best record for a CCC school at the tournament. Was named Adidas Team of the Week for Aug. 19-25 for its performance at the Red Lion Challenge. Currently on a five match road trip in Florida, where they will face the No. 5 Oklahoma Baptist and No. 10 Embry-Riddle (Fla.) at the Embry-Riddle Labor Day Tournament

Evergreen - The Geoducks used a four-set victory over Montana Western to secure their first win since 2010 and break a 51-match losing streak. The win over the Bulldogs came in the final match of the Red Lion Cascade/Frontier Challenge at The HUB Sports Center in Liberty Lake, Wash.

Northwest - None Provided

Northwest Christian - The Beacons are looking for a strong start as they begin the year with a five-game trek through Northern California. NCU is a combined 14-1 all-time against the teams that are on the schedule.

Oregon Tech - None Provided

Southern Oregon - The Raiders came away from the Biola Invitational without a win against the Nos. 1, 4, 16 and 18 teams in the NAIA, but received some stellar performances. Senior libero Renee Yomtob averaged 5.3 digs per set and senior hitter Liz Madden posted 2.1 kills per set. They host the Paul Elliott Invitational on Thursday and Friday.

Warner Pacific - Warner Pacific earned their first win of the 2013 season with a 3-0 sweep of Simpson University on Monday night. Julia Toscano had 15 kills, while senior Kristina Naff added a career high 10 kills.
