## Around The Cascade Conference

**College of Idaho** - None Provided

**Concordia**- Sitting at 3-1-0 with three 2-0 wins and a lone loss at No. 11 ranked Hastings College, the Concordia men's soccer team will take a nine-day break from competition before opening CCC play at Northwest University on Sept. 17.

**Corban** - Since the inception of the 14-game CCC schedule in 2009, the Warriors have never gone undefeated in non-conference play with the 2012 squad holding the best record previously at 1-1-2. One year ago, Corban also set a new single-season school record for Goals Against Average (GAA) at 0.94 and are already ahead of that pace early in the season as the Warriors have allowed only one goal so far this season for a GAA of 0.50.

**Evergreen** - The Geoducks will wrap up the non-conference portion of their schedule on Saturday afternoon when they take on NCAA DIII Whitworth University in a neutral-site match at Willamette University in Salem, Ore. The Pirates will also take on the UC Santa Cruz Banana Slugs while in Oregon, giving Whitworth back-to-back matches against mascots from the phylum Mollusca.

**Northwest** - None provided

**Northwest Christian** - The Beacons are currently second in the CCC in saves, averaging five per game. They are led in goal by Max Torres who is currently fifth in the CCC with ten saves.

**Oregon Tech** - None Provided

**Warner Pacific** - WP men's soccer found their scoring touch in a 5-3 win at Trinity Lutheran College last weekend. Jameson Jones and Andres Campos each scored a pair of goals, while Adler Pottebaum scored his first career goal. Almir Celebic passed for three assists. The Knights open CCC play with a tough challenge – a trip to Olympia to face a dangerous Evergreen side.
