Around The Cascade Conference

College of Idaho - None Provided

Concordia - With a No. 23 ranking this week, the Cavaliers entered the NAIA Top 25 for the first time in over a decade. The last time CU had entered the top 25 was with a No. 17 ranking in September 2003 in the Preseason Poll. After falling to No. 4-ranked Biola University on August 23, Concordia has reeled off six straight wins including NCAA DII Saint Martin's on Tuesday.

Corban - After the opening weekend of Cascade Collegiate Conference play, Corban returns to action on Friday and Saturday in Portland against Concordia and Warner Pacific. So far this season, Corban is unbeaten in its lone match on the road thanks to a come-from-behind victory in five sets over NCAA Division III member George Fox. The Warriors have played eight matches away from Salem this season with seven happening on a neutral court. Junior libero Katherine Salness ranks in the Top 5 in the Cascade Collegiate Conference in both service aces (4th – 0.50) and digs (5th – 4.59) per set, which leads the Warriors in each category.

Eastern Oregon - EOU is ranked No. 16 in the Tachikara-NAIA Volleyball Coaches' Poll. This is the highest ranking in program history for EOU Volleyball. Eastern Oregon has won five straight matches and with wins over College of Idaho and Walla Walla University at Quinn Coliseum, the Mountaineers have won 11 straight home matches.

Evergreen - The Geoducks broke a 51-match losing streak in August and then a 39-match CCC losing streak on Saturday and now have their eyes set on ending a 27-match road losing streak. It won't be easy as Evergreen heads to defending champion College of Idaho on Friday and 16th-ranked Eastern Oregon on Saturday.

Northwest - None Provided

Northwest Christian - This weekend the Beacons won their CCC opener for the first time in school history, knocking off OIT in three sets on Friday night. Then on Saturday the Beacons defeated then-receiving votes Southern Oregon, also in straight sets. It was NCU's first-ever win against SOU in 14 tries.

Oregon Tech - None Provided

Southern Oregon - SOU's fourth straight win Friday at Corban was followed by a disappointing loss Saturday at Northwest Christian that marked the Beacons' first win in 14 meetings all-time with the Raiders. Liz Madden -- who continued her stellar play with nine kills in each match -- will lead the Raiders (4-5 overall, 1-1 CCC) into Friday's match at Oregon Tech, where they haven't lost since 2001.

Warner Pacific - The Knight Volleyball team dropped to 2-8 on the season with losses at Northwest and Evergreen to open CCC play. Julia Toscano continued her solid season with 25 kills last weekend, but the team as a whole did not break .100 attack percentage in either match.
