Cascade Conference Golf Roundup

COLLEGE OF IDAHO

Kyle DeLorey shot the lowest 54-hole total in C of I history at the OIT Invite (71-73-69)...Baylee Borchers has earned medalist honors in both tournaments to start 2013

CONCORDIA

Jesse Heinly, the 2011-12 CCC Player of the Year, made a triumphant 2013-14 debut with a 7-under 209 last week at the Oregon Tech Invite. Heinly's second-round 5-under 67 was two shy of a career best at Concordia and three shy of Tyler Austin's single-round school record 64. His 209 tally for a 54-hole tournament was nine strokes off his career best of 200 set in 2011. Through one CCC event, Concordia holds a 30-stroke lead over OIT in the league standings. Holly Winburn, a sophomore, turned in three straight 6-over 78s at the Oregon Tech Invite to place second overall and lead Concordia to a 10-stroke team win. Winburn's score of 234 was a 21-stroke career-best for a three-round tournament. Her 6-over 78 in the opening round was a 3-stroke career best for a single round, a score she matched in the following two rounds of play.

CORBAN

Corban will head to Medford this weekend to take part in the Border War hosted by Oregon Tech. Three Cascade Collegiate Conference schools - Corban, Oregon Tech, and The College of Idaho - will battle against a trio of California Pacific Conference teams - Simpson, Menlo, and William Jessup - for the right to be called the best conference on the West Coast. Coming off his first collegiate victory at last weekend's Pacific Fall Invitational, Jared Lambert will look to add to his trophy case with a win at Centennial Golf Club, while Brooke Spencer looks to continue her stellar play this fall in which she has either tied or broke the single-round school-record four times in five rounds this year.

NORTHWEST CHRISTIAN

Tyler Falk shot a 68 in the second round of the OIT Invitational last week. It was the third 68 of his career, tying his own school record.

OREGON TECH

Oregon Tech men and women will return to the links on Sunday & Monday, September 29th & 30th, at the Border War at Centennial Golf Club in Medford. Both rounds will begin at 1:00 p.m.

WARNER PACIFIC

The Warner Pacific men's golf team placed 4th at the Oregon Tech Invitational. Senior A.J. Nelson led the way for WP by placing 6th overall. Scotti Jo Helmick was the top finisher for the Warner Pacific women at the Oregon Tech Invite. The junior was 10 strokes off the lead and placed 3rd overall. The Knights did not field a full team but will be entering a full squad in future events.
