Around The Cascade Conference

College of Idaho - Keeper Colin Benham-Marin has stopped three of his last five penalty kick chances dating back to last year.

Concordia - No. 16th-ranked CU men's soccer team earned a road split in the first week of CCC play by posting a 5-0 win at NCU following a 3-2 loss at Northwest. The Cavs will play on back-to-back days for the first time this season when they host Oregon Tech and College of Idaho on Sept. 27-28. A total of 18 different players have received at least one starting nod in six games so far this season with defender Jordan Green, midfielder Radcliffe McDougald and goalkeeper Scott Gross the lone players to make every start in 2013.

Corban - The Warriors will take on fellow CCC co-leaders Northwest today in Salem, as both teams are looking to sit atop of current league standings. Corban is in the midst of the second-best start in program history, as the Warriors are riding a season-opening five-game winning streak and will match the best start in school history (6-0-0 in 1990) with a victory against the visiting Eagles. Through five games, Corban's defense has allowed just one goal in 360 minutes of action with the Warriors allowing 0.20 goals per game that includes a 1-0 forfeit win over Trinity Lutheran earlier this month.

Evergreen - Sophomore Willie Spurr, the 2012 CCC Newcomer of the Year, already has three goals on the season, including two in CCC play.

Northwest - The NU men hope to extend their three game winning streak with a tough road trip to Corban and Northwest Christian.

Northwest Christian - NCU will play at Evergreen on Wednesday. The Beacons are 0-9-2 all-time against the Geoducks, who have won three straight in the series. On Saturday NCU will host Northwest. The Beacons are 3-8-1 all-time against the Eagles but have dropped four straight.

Oregon Tech - Oregon Tech will try to win back to back CCC matches for the first time since 2010, unfortunately for the Owls they play at No. 12 Concordia who has won the last seven meetings between the two schools.

Warner Pacific - Warner Pacific fell at home to Corban 3-0, dropping the Knights to 0-2 in CCC play. Goalkeeper Dorian Lair has been a bright spot for WP - he leads the CCC with 6.5 saves per game.
