Around The Cascade Conference

College of Idaho - Homecoming weekend brings Southern Oregon and Oregon Tech to Caldwell, as Lady Yotes put a CCC-record 73-match home win streak in league play on the line...Liz Myers became the first-ever C of I player to record 10-or-more blocks in back-to-back matches.

Concordia - The No. 20-ranked Concordia volleyball team takes a 10-match winning streak to NCAA DII Western Oregon on Wednesday in the team's final non-conference bout of the season. Of the 10 wins in CU's winning streak, nine have come in three-set sweeps while the final win came in a 3-1 victory at home against NCAA DII St. Martin's University on Sept. 10. The Cavs' last loss came at No. 3-ranked Biola University on August 23.

Corban - Coming off two tough matches against The College of Idaho and nationally-ranked Eastern Oregon, Corban hits the road and heads to the state of Washington this weekend to take on Evergreen and Northwest. The Warriors will look to end their season-opening six-game conference skid against the Geoducks and Eagles. So far this season, Corban is 1-2 on the road.

Eastern Oregon - EOU Volleyball is on a season high nine game winning streak and has won 20 consecutive sets. The last set the Mountaineers have dropped was on August 31 to Embry-Riddle. The Mountaineers continue to make school history as they climb in the Tachikara-NAIA Coaches' Top 25 Poll. EOU is ranked No. 11. Casey Loper was named CCC Red Lion Offensive Player of the Week for her Performance from Sept. 16-22.

Evergreen - The Geoducks will look for a pair of wins this weekend as they host Corban and Northwest Christian in the first weekend with a full campus.

Northwest - The Eagles hope to rebound from three straight shutout losses when they host Northwest Christian and Corban in Kirkland this weekend. No date set yet for the Evergreen re-schedule.

Northwest Christian - Sitting at 3-3 in the Cascade Collegiate Conference, NCU will look to move up in the standings this weekend against Northwest and Evergreen. NCU is 4-9 all-time against the Eagles, with whom they split last season's series. The Beacons are 10-3 all-time against the Geoducks and have won four straight in the series.

Oregon Tech - Oregon Tech's Kelsey Sampson has the most kills of any Freshman in the CCC with an average of 2.81 kills per set.

Southern Oregon - Freshman setter Lauren McGowne continued her impressive play, exceeding her season-high assist totals for the second and third straight matches, and senior libero Renee Yomtob moved into third place on SOU's all-time digs list as the Raiders split in CCC play last weekend. This weekend the Raiders will head to College of Idaho, where they have lost nine of their last 10, and Eastern Oregon, which knocked them out in the second round of last year's conference tournament, before settling in for five straight at home.

Warner Pacific - The Knights volleyball team managed to take a set in each match at Oregon Tech and Southern Oregon, but dropped both contests 3-1. Julia Toscano continues her solid season - she is #6 in the CCC with 3.13 kills per set.
