## Around The Cascade Conference

**College of Idaho** - Liz Myers tied a school record with 11 block assists in the five-set loss to Northwest Nazarene on Saturday.

**Concordia** - With a 4-2 record, Concordia has fared well against quality competition so far this season. The Cavaliers upset No. 20-ranked CSU San Marcos and nearly defeated a second top-20 ranked team in No. 16-ranked Westmont College. In addition, the Cavs toppled Vanguard University 3-1 and Lewis-Clark State College 3-0 as teams that received votes in the NAIA Coaches' Preseason Poll.

**Corban** - None Provided

**Eastern Oregon** - The Mounties went 4-1 in Florida and now sit at 9-2 for the season. While in Florida, EOU upset No. 10 Embry-Riddle (Fla.), 3-1 (25-23, 18-25, 25-20, 25-15). EOU had the CCC Red Lion Players of the Week for Volleyball. Casey Loper, was named Offensive Player of the week. Jessalynn Smith was named Defensive Player of the week.

**Evergreen** - Evergreen, who recently broke a 51-match losing streak against Montana Western, will look to break a 38-match CCC losing streak this weekend when they play host to Concordia on Friday and Warner Pacific on Saturday..

**Northwest** - Northwest will be happy to be home after playing their first 9 matches on the road. They open CCC play with Warner Pacific (Fri.) and Concordia (Sat.).

**Northwest Christian** - The march toward history has kicked into high gear for a pair of Beacon seniors. Janel Fetters, already NCU's all-time blocks leader, has collected 734 career kills and needs 137 more to set a new school record. Dana McGowan is sitting on 1351 career digs, needing 198 more for the Beacons all-time record.

**Oregon Tech** - Oregon Tech Ranks 7th in Nation in Total Service Aces (74).

**Southern Oregon** - After beginning its season with four straight losses to ranked squads, the Raiders (3-4) swept three matches in convincing fashion at their own Paul Elliott Invitational to bring some momentum into the first week of Cascade Conference play. Senior hitter Liz Madden shined with 29 a total of 29 kills and hitting averages above .400 in all three contests -- helping the Raiders as a team hit at clips of .306, .387 and .385.

**Warner Pacific** - The Knights swept Mills College in their only match of the week. Julia Toscano is off to a good start this season, averaging 3.00 kills per set which is #7 in the CCC.
