Evergreen and Northwest hit the road, traveling to the Rose City to take on Warner Pacific and Concordia in a quartet of games in Portland. CU then hosts Portland Bible on Tuesday in a non-conference game.

The final game matches Oregon Tech traveling to Southern Oregon as OIT head coach Danny Miles looks for his 999th career win against his alma mater.

Around The Cascade Conference

College of Idaho - Coyotes put a seven-game home win streak on the line this weekend against Corban and Northwest Christian...with a win, the Yotes would equal their win total for the entire 2012-13 season

Concordia - Concordia has six players averaging at least nine points per game this season. Adam Herman leads the CCC at 25.1 points per game and is followed by Willy Ligon with 14.6 points per game while coming off the bench. Starting point guard Tyler Velasquez and guard Anthony Holton holds 10.0 and 10.0 averages while post Esvan Middleton has added 9.6 points per contest. Thomas Pierce has missed the last 10 games due to injury but was coming through with 12.4 points per game before being sidelined.

Corban - Over the weekend, Corban extends its NAIA-record to 889 straight games with at least one three-pointer made as the Warriors trail NCAA Division I member UNLV by a mere two games for the all-time longest streak among four-year schools. Freshman Caleb Herzberg leads Corban's long-range show, as the first-year Warrior has hit 47 shots from beyond the arc and ranks third in the Cascade Collegiate Conference in three-point field goal percentage at .490 (47-for-96).

Eastern Oregon - EOU was 1-1 last week with a win over Walla Walla, Tuesday night and were defeated by College of Idaho, Friday evening. Against Walla Walla Kyllian Wood led the Mountaineers as he scored 28 points and collected 20 rebounds. The 20 rebound game was the most rebounds for a single EOU player since, Feb. 18, 2000. Eastern Oregon ranks third in the nation in total blocks (87) and blocks per game (5.1).

Evergreen - After playing No. 6 Southern Oregon to within just four points on Friday night, the Geoducks finally broke into the win column on Saturday, using a strong team performance to pick up a win over Oregon Tech. It broke a 10-game losing streak against the Hustlin' Owls that dated back to 2008.

Northwest - The NU men head to Portland for two tough games with Warner Pacific and Concordia this weekend in the hopes of maintaining their position at the top of the CCC. NU did not fare well last season as they dropped both contests at WPC and CU on the road.

Northwest Christian - Sophomore Post Austin Kuemper continues to be the prize jewel of Luke Jackson's first Beacon team. Kuemper is averaging 19 points and 9.7 rebounds per game. He is third in the CCC in scoring and second in rebounding, while also leading the NCU with a 74% clip at the free-throw line.

Oregon Tech - Head Coach Danny Miles is just two wins away from 1000. Miles stands No. 2 on the all-time men's college basketball head coach wins list in any level of 4-year institutions (NCAA, NAIA). Harry Statham of NCAA Division II McKendree (Ill.) holds 1,074 career wins to top the list. Coach Miles will look for win No. 999 on Saturday night when the Hustlin' Owls play at Rival Southern Oregon University. Hustlin' Owls are ranked number 1 in NAIA D II in Total 3-Pt FG Made (216)

Southern Oregon - Eric Thompson's 38-point effort at Evergreen helped seventh-ranked SOU to a split last weekend in Washington. And with the career-high output, Thompson passed Ryan Harbert and moved into third place on SOU's all-time scoring list with 1,588 points in his career. Saturday will mark the 226th meeting between the Raiders and Oregon Tech. This edition will be played in Ashland with SOU going for its fifth straight win.

Warner Pacific - After averaging 22 points per game during two key road victories last weekend, Doug Thomas was named Red Lion Player of the Week. Thomas continues to lead the Knights in scoring this season at 15.9 points per game.
