Around The Cascade Conference

College of Idaho - Lady Yotes return home for tilts against Corban and Northwest Christian...all five C of I starters average in double-figures, with Dayna Drager averaging 27 points a game over the Yotes last two games.

Concordia - Concordia will look for its first home win of the season with Northwest and Evergreen arriving in Portland this weekend. The Cavaliers are 0-6 at home while posting a 3-9 record in away games. The Cavs have given up 88.2 points per game in its six home games against just 71.8 per game while playing on the road.

Corban - Nearing the midway point of the Cascade Collegiate Conference season, Corban sits only one game behind Eastern Oregon for the first place in the current standings as the Warriors are also 1½ games in front of Oregon Tech and Southern Oregon. Junior Tara Vanweerdhuizen joined an elite group over the weekend, as the third-year Warrior became the 16th player in program history to score 1,000-or-more points in a career and is on pace to become only the third player in school history to register more than 1,000 points and 1,000 rebounds in her career.

Eastern Oregon - EOU enters this weekend ranked No. 14 in the NAIA Division II Women's Basketball Coaches' Top 25. The Mountaineers have won 27 straight conference games. The last conference loss for EOU was Feb. 10, 2012 when College of Idaho defeated EOU, 44-40. Eastern Oregon currently has won 31 straight contests at Quinn Coliseum. The last loss for EOU at home was on Jan. 7, 2012 when Corban defeated EOU, 73-59. EOU has made a 156 three pointers on the year, which is sixth best in the NAIA. Brittney Newcomb leads the Mountaineers attack from behind the arc as she ranks 2nd in the nation in made three pointers per game averaging 4.1 per game.

Evergreen - The Geoducks will look for a pair of wins this weekend as they take on a pair of schools below them on the conference table in Concordia (Friday) and Warner Pacific (Saturday).

Northwest - Coach Ken Crawford makes his first trip to Portland to play Warner Pacific and Concordia in his first year as the Eagle head coach. The Eagles hope to improve upon their 0-4 record against the two schools last season.

Northwest Christian - The Beacons put together their first two-game winning streak of the season, sweeping Concordia and Warner Pacific at home last weekend. The wins vaulted NCU from tenth place all the way up to a tie for seventh place in the CCC. Sophomore Chandler Gabrio had a career game against Concordia on Friday, scoring 27 points and 15 rebounds, both season-highs for the Beacons.

Oregon Tech - Lady Owls rank number 1 in NAIA DII in Total Assists (399) and in Field Goal Pct Defense (0.332) Kassi Conditt is 3rd in DII in Blocks per Game (3.200) and 3rd in Total Blocks (64).

Southern Oregon - Allison Gida's career-best weekend earned her the Red Lion Cascade Conference Player of the Week award and got the Raiders two big road wins in Washington. Gida had 17 points, 15 rebounds, six assists and seven steals in an 86-72 win at Evergreen, then went for 26 points and 13 rebounds in a 101-94 win at Northwest. Thanks to her and Carly Meister, the Raiders rank sixth in the NAIA in rebounds per game (47.4). They've won six of their last nine against Oregon Tech going into Saturday's matchup in Ashland.

Warner Pacific - Ali Campbell broke out of a scoring slump with a career high 21 points during the loss at Northwest Christian.
