Around The Cascade Conference

College of Idaho - Coyotes climbed to #14 in latest NAIA Top-25 poll, their highest regular-season ranking since Feb. 15, 2007...C of I rallied from a 12-point second half deficit to defeat NCU on Saturday, their first win in six tries this season when trailing at halftime.

Concordia - Concordia will carry an eight-game winning streak heading into its matchup against Warner Pacific on Saturday. The streak is the longest by a CU men's basketball team since a 9-0 run to start the 2009-10 season. Concordia's longest winning streak occurred in the 1999-2000 season when the Cavs rattled off 13 straight victories.

Corban - Corban will continue its four-game road trip this weekend in the state of Washington against nationally-ranked Northwest and Evergreen. Junior Jordan Carter is 66 points shy of becoming the 15th player in program history to score 1,500 career points, as the third-year Warrior is only 60 points away from moving into the Top 15 all-time in scoring in school history. The Warriors extended their NAIA-record to 891 straight games making at least one three-pointer, as Corban trails only NCAA Division I member UNLV (893-and-counting) for the all-time record among four-year schools.

Eastern Oregon - The Mountaineers snapped a two game losing streak on Saturday evening with a 74-65 victory over Corban. EOU is second in the nation in total block shots. The Mountaineers have blocked 95 shots on the season led by Kalvin Johanson. Johanson has 43 blocks on the season.

Evergreen - Despite just one CCC win this season, the Geoducks are just two games out of the playoff hunt as they have been much improved since the calendar has turned to 2014. Evergreen will look for a win or two this weekend as they host Northwest Christian on Friday and Corban on Saturday.

Northwest - The NU men hope to break a two game losing streak when they host Corban and Northwest Christian this weekend at home. NU dropped both games in their trip to Eugene and Salem in December. Senior forward Michael Greene is currently ranked #8 in the NAIA D-II in FG percentage with a .627 average. Senior guard Brett Skogstad is #10 in the NAIA in 3-point FG percentage, shooting at a .472 clip.

Northwest Christian - The Beacons travel to face Northwest University on Saturday night, looking to break a current tie for fifth place in the CCC. NCU defeated the Eagles at home earlier this season, 72-65, the first win in the series for Northwest Christian since 2010.

Oregon Tech - Friday Night will be the 167th meeting on the hardwoods between Oregon Tech and Eastern Oregon University where the Owls hold a 97-69 overall advantage over the Mountaineers.

Southern Oregon - The ninth-ranked Raiders won their fifth straight game in the rivalry series against Oregon Tech on Saturday, 86-74, and the stakes will remain high this week when first-place College of Idaho comes to town on Friday and Eastern Oregon is in Ashland on Saturday. Jeff Bush is the nation's second-leading assist man (6.7/ game), and Eric Thompson ranks second in the CCC in scoring (22.1) and seventh in rebounding (8.5).

Warner Pacific - The Knights have moved into a tie for second place in the CCC after posting a winning streak of 5 games. Ryan Parks made 5 three pointers on Saturday versus Evergreen, moving him into the #2 spot in career three pointers made (190) at Warner Pacific.
