## Around The Cascade Conference

**College of Idaho** - Lady Yotes set a new school record by connecting on 15 three-pointers in their Saturday win over NCU...Elisha Hensey tied a school record with 11 assists in the win over NCU.

**Concordia** - Four players have made an appearance in all 20 games for the Cavaliers this season, including three freshmen. Guards Lexi Campbell and Briannah Smith and forward Stephanie Luce have seen action in every contest while junior center Caitlyn McCutcheon is the only player to start all 20 games for the Cavs in 2013-14.

**Corban** - Sitting in a three-way tie for second place in the current conference standings at the midway point, Corban continues its four-game road trip this weekend in the state of Washington. Sophomore Julia Young currently leads the Warriors in free throw percentage having hit 61-of-70 (.871) this year that includes a stretch of 25 straight over a seven-game span. Over the past eight games, sophomore Jade Lowery has scored in double figures in five contests and increased her scoring average to 11.7 points per game and has surpassed her season total for points from last year through Corban's first 20 games this season.

**Eastern Oregon** - EOU has won 29 straight conference contests dating back to The last conference loss for Eastern Oregon came on Feb. 10, 2012 when College of Idaho defeated EOU, 44-40. Eastern Oregon held steady at No. 14 in the fifth edition of the NAIA Division II Women's Basketball Coaches' Top 25.

**Evergreen** - Junior Brittany Gray was named Red Lion Cascade Conference Player of the Week for the second time this season after leading the Geoducks to their first ever road sweep in Portland. The Geoducks will look to continue the winning streak this weekend against Northwest Christian and Corban.

**Northwest** - The Eagle women have look to improve their record as they host Corban and Northwest Christian this weekend in the NU Pavilion. Eagle guard Jordan Asher is #1 in the CCC and NAIA in 3-point FG percentage with an impressive .568 in CCC games and .485 overall percentage. She hit 80% (4 for 5) of her treys against Concordia. The team is #1 in the CCC in total rebounds with 895 so this season.

**Northwest Christian** - With both starting post players sidelined, sophomore Chandler Gabrio has come into her own over the past three weeks. In the 5 games that she has started since January 3, Gabrio is averaging 18.2 points and 9.4 rebounds per game. She is shooting 47% from the field and 72% at the free throw line in those games.

**Oregon Tech** - Lady Owls rank 2nd in NAIA DII in total assists (416), 2nd in total Block shots (124), and 2nd in Field Goal Percentage Defense (.0335). 3rd in NAIA DII in Assist/Turnover Ratio (1.355) and 3rd in Blocks per game (5.905)

**Southern Oregon** - Though Southern Oregon suffered its first loss against Oregon Tech in Ashland since 2006, Allison Gida continued to fill up the stat sheet. The senior scored a career-high 28 points with 12 rebounds -- her third straight double-double -- and now averages 15.5 points, 9 rebounds and 3 assists in conference play.

**Warner Pacific** - Warner Pacific will try to snap a 5 game losing streak this weekend at Concordia.
