10th-ranked and first-place College of Idaho will be tested this week as they host 21st-ranked Concordia on Friday and Warner Pacific on Saturday. The Cavaliers and Knights will also play at Eastern Oregon this weekend.

Oregon Tech head coach Danny Miles will be going for his 1000th win this weekend as the Hustlin' Owls visit Northwest Christian and Corban. NCU and CRB also host Southern Oregon. In the final game, Northwest travels to Evergreen in a battle of in-state rivals.

Around The Cascade Conference

College of Idaho - Coyote men climbed to #10 in the NAIA Top-25 poll, their highest regular-season ranking since Jan. 14, 2007 (#9)...Yotes swept SOU/OIT road trip for the first time since 2003.

Concordia - Concordia tied its second longest winning streak in school history last week with a win over Warner Pacific on Saturday. CU opened the 2009-10 season 9-0 and won a school record 13 straight during the 1999-2000 season.

Corban - Returning home for the first time in nearly three weeks, Corban welcomes nationally-ranked Southern Oregon and Oregon Tech to the Capital City. Junior Jordan Carter has scored in double-digits in 12 straight games, as the third-year Warrior has compiled a combined 202 points (avg. 16.8) on 74-for-134 (55.2%) shooting from the field over that stretch.

Eastern Oregon - EOU ranks second in the NAIA in block shots. Eastern Oregon has blocked 100 shots on the season and only sit behind conference rival College of Idaho in block shots. Tony Eackles leads the Mountaineers in scoring as he is averaging 17.6 points per game. Eackles has lead EOU in scoring in 13 games this season.

Evergreen - The Geoducks doubled their CCC win total over the last two seasons with an impressive 15-point win over Corban last Saturday. Evergreen will look for a second-straight win this weekend when they host Northwest on Saturday.

Northwest - he Eagles take a short trip down Interstate 5 to take on in-state rival Evergreen this Saturday. It will be the third meeting for the teams this season. NU's Michael Greene is nearing the 1,500 career points mark as he will enter Saturday's game with 1,467 points . Greene leads the team in scoring with a 16.8 ppg average and is ranked #6 in the NAIA in field goal percentage with a .627 shooting average.

Northwest Christian - None Provided.

Oregon Tech - Ranks Number 1 in Division II in Total Blocks (135) and Blocks per Game (5.870)Ranks Number 1 in Field Goal Pct Defense (0.336) Ranks 2nd in Total Assists (449)

Southern Oregon - Jeff Bush registered a career-high 14 assists in Friday's 2OT loss to College of Idaho -- SOU's first 2OT game in 10 years -- which was good for the third-highest single game total in school history. In Saturday's win against Eastern, he helped the Raiders with a game-high 18 points and five assists. He currently leads the nation at 7 assists per game.

Warner Pacific - The Knights had a 5 game winning streak snapped with the loss at Concordia. Josh Black passed for 5 assists during the game, giving him 372 for his career. The total moves him to #4 all-time at WPC.
