Oregon Tech and Southern Oregon head north to take on Corban and Northwest Christian as both the Lady Owls and Raiders look for important wins as they hope to host playoff games at the end of the month.

Eastern Oregon holds a three-game lead in the standings but they will have to keep winning to lock up the number one seed, joining College of Idaho this weekend in hosting Concordia and Warner Pacific.

The final game matches Northwest at Evergreen in a battle of in-state rivals.

## Around The Cascade Conference

**College of Idaho** - Lady Yotes knocked off their third ranked opponent of the season with their win at OIT...C of I has hit nine or more three-pointers in six-straight games and lead the CCC in three-point percentage and three-pointers made per game

**Concordia** - Senior guard Gabi Beyer enters the week third on CU's all-time 3-point list with 99 career makes from long distance. Beyer is fourth in school history in career 3-point attempts (316) and 11th in 3-point percentage (.313).

**Corban** - After playing its last four games on the road, Corban returns to the C.E. Jeffers Sports Center against Southern Oregon and nationally-ranked Oregon Tech this weekend. Since the start of CCC play, sophomore Jade Lowery has averaged just under 13 points per game raising her season scoring average to 11.6 points per contest and currently ranks second on the team in that offensive category.

**Eastern Oregon** - EOU has won 32 straight contests at Quinn Coliseum. EOU is 10-0 at home this season. The last loss for EOU at Quinn Coliseum came on Jan. 7, 2012 when then-No. 22 Corban defeated EOU, 73-59. Eastern Oregon suffered its first conference loss since, Feb. 10, 2012 last Friday night when Oregon Tech defeated EOU, 58-50. Brittney Newcomb leads the NAIA in free throw percentage. On the season, Newcomb is shooting 90.6 percent from the free throw line. EOU dropped two spots to No. 16 in the sixth edition of the NAIA Division II Women's Basketball Coaches' Top 25

**Evergreen** - A pair of wins last weekend pushed the Geoducks' current win streak to four games, a school record for conference play. Evergreen will try to make it five in a row on Saturday when they host Northwest. The Geoducks and Eagles have already split a pair of games this year, with each team winning on the road.

**Northwest** - The NU Eagles will play their in-state rival Evergreen for the third time this season with the series tied at 1-1 this year with each team winning on the road. Northwest's Jordan Asher still leads the NAIA in 3-point FG percentage with a .486 shooting average from behind the arc. She went 4 for 8 over the weekend for a 50% average. The team is #7 in the NAIA in offensive rebounds with 979 boards for the year.

**Northwest Christian** - None Provided.

**Oregon Tech** - Ranks Number 1 in Division II in Total Blocks (135) and Blocks per Game (5.870) Ranks Number 1 in Field Goal Pct Defense (0.336) Ranks 2nd in Total Assists (449).

**Southern Oregon** - The consistent play of Kristen Schoenherr got the Raiders one big win last week against College of Idaho and nearly got them another over first-place Eastern Oregon before they lost a nine-point halftime lead. The sophomore guard averaged 26 points, 6.5 assists, 6 rebounds and 2.5 steals on her way to player of the week honors. Over her last right games, she's 57 of 93 from the field.

**Warner Pacific** - WP broke a four game losing streak by defeating Concordia on the road last Saturday. The result moved the Knights into a tie with NCU for the 8th and final CCC playoff spot.
