Around The Cascade Conference

College of Idaho - C of I's win at WP on Friday was their first at Bart Valentine Court since 2005...Demetrius Perkins has scored at least nine points in 15-straight games, including his season-high 30 on Friday...Yotes head to EOU looking for their first back-to-back road wins in La Grande in a decade.

Concordia - Senior Adam Herman, who leads the CCC with 25.7 points per game, is one point shy of tying Concordia's all-time career mark. With 1,882 career points, Herman will likely pass former CU All-American Alphonso Niles (1996-2000) all-time mark of 1,883 points on Friday at Northwest Christian. In 96 career games, Herman holds a 19.6 points per game scoring average. The senior already owns the school record for career field goal percentage (.646) and made free throws (442).

Corban - Corban returns home for the first time this year to face Warner Pacific and Concordia, as the Warriors look to extend their home winning streak to three games. Freshman Caleb Herzberg continues to lead the team and conference in three-point field goal percentage, as the first-year Warriors has knocked down 51.8% (44-of-85) from beyond the arch this season. As a team, Corban ranks third in the conference in three-point field goal percentage having hit 35.2% (109-for-310) from long distance.

Eastern Oregon - Kyllian Wood scored 28 points and collected 20 rebounds in the Mountaineers, 93-84, victory over Walla Walla University, Tuesday night. The Mountaineers have hit 10 or more three pointers in six games this season. Tuesday night the Mountaineers defeated Walla Walla University, 93-84, in its last non-conference game of the season.

Evergreen - Returning home for the first time in 2014, the Geoducks will play host to No. 6 Southern Oregon on Friday before hosting Oregon Tech on Saturday.

Northwest - The Eagles have two key CCC games this weekend when they host Oregon Tech and nationally ranked Southern Oregon in Kirkland. Tech's coach, Dan Miles, comes to town with 998 career wins and has the Owls playing well after a sweep of last weekend's CCC games. SOU and Northwest always have battles when the teams meet. The two teams split last season's league meetings with both teams winning their road games.

Northwest Christian - A member of the NAIA since 2007, Northwest Christian made their debut in the NAIA Top-25 coaches poll this week, claiming the No. 25 spot. Individually, the Beacons shine bright with all five starters averaging at least 9.7 points per game. Sophomore Post Austin Kuemper averages 19.5 points per game, which is third in the conference. Spencer Coleman is close behind in sixth place, averaging 17.9 ppg. Kuemper is also second in the conference and ninth in the NAIA in rebounding, averaging 9.6 rebounds per game. He averages a double-double in CCC games.

Oregon Tech - Head Coach Danny Miles is just two wins away from 1000. Miles stands No. 2 on the all-time men's college basketball head coach wins list in any level of 4-year institutions (NCAA, NAIA). Harry Statham of NCAA Division II McKendree (Ill.) holds 1,074 career wins (as of Jan. 5) to top the list. He goes for No. 999 on Jan. 10 at Northwest (Wash.) and potentially No. 1,000 on Jan. 11 at Evergreen (Wash.).
