Around The Cascade Conference

College of Idaho - Dayna Drager scored 36 points in Saturday's win over CU, equaling the third-highest scoring game in program history...Chakala Carthen is averaging nearly 17 points and 12 rebounds a game in CCC play and leads the league with nine double-doubles...C of I heads to EOU, looking to end Eastern's 26-game CCC win streak (dating back to a 44-40 loss at C of I in 2011-12)

Concordia - Caitlyn McCutcheon is one of four players in the CCC with a top-10 conference ranking in points and rebounds. McCutcheon is ranked No. 3 in rebounding (9.7 rpg) and No. 10 in scoring (13.3 ppg). Southern Oregon's Carly Meister, College of Idaho's Chakala Carthen and Evergreen's Brittany Gray also have top-10 rankings in each category. McCutcheon is also ranked No. 5 in field goal percentage (.500) and No. 4 in blocks (1.2 bpg).

Corban - Corban, who is coming off an upset of then-No. 17-ranked Southern Oregon, welcomes the visiting Knights of Warner Pacific and Cavaliers of Concordia to Salem this weekend in hopes of keeping pace at the top of the conference standings. Going into this weekend, junior Tara Vanweerdhuizen is only 25 points away from becoming the 16th player in program history to score 1,000-or-more points in a career. In 79 games during her career as a Warrior, Vanweerdhuizen has score 975 points to go along with 815 rebounds and a school-record 268 blocked shots.

Eastern Oregon - EOU improved 11 spots in the NAIA Division II Women's Basketball Coaches' Top 25 Poll to No. 13. For the third time this season Brittney Newcomb was named CCC Red Lion Player of the Week. EOU has won 26 straight conference games. The Mountaineers look to continue the winning streak this Friday against College of Idaho.

Evergreen - The Geoducks rank third in the country in rebound defense per game, allowing opponents just 32.48 rebounds per game. That ranking may be in jeopardy this weekend as Evergreen hosts two of the top rebounding teams in the country in Southern Oregon and Oregon Tech.

Northwest - The NU women face a big challenge when they welcome OIT, currently ranked No. 20 in the NAIA Top 25 poll. Southern Oregon is right on top of NU in the CCC standings with a 3-3 league mark while the Eagles sport a 2-3 CCC record. The Eagles are finally recovering from the flu bug which hit half the team right after their road trip to NCU and Corban.

Northwest Christian - The Beacons are currently ranked third in the CCC in blocks, averaging 3.2 blocks per game. This number is fueled by sophomore Andrea Gloss, who individually ranks third in the conference, averaging 1.5 bpg. Gloss had 25 blocks as a freshman and already ranks 4th on NCU's all-time list with 45

Oregon Tech - Lady Owls Rank number 1 in NAIA DII in Total Assists and in Field Goal Pct Defense (0.318) Tech's Kassi Conditt Ranks in the Top 10 in the NAIA DII in 3 categories, she is 3rd in Total Block Shots at (54), 5th in Total rebounds (160), and 6th in Blocks per game at (3.00)
