Around The Cascade Conference

College of Idaho - C of I opened a five-match road swing with a 3-0 win at Oregon Tech on Saturday...Joe Bolin leads team with 7 goals and now has 17 for his career.

Concordia - Through seven matches, 10 difference Cavaliers have scored at least one goal this season, Kevin Fischer and Ben Culpan lead the team with three goals each while Timur Zhividze and Tyler Hoiem have both scored on two occasions.

Corban - Corban takes to the road on Wednesday to play first-place Concordia in a pivotal conference match. The Warriors then host Warner Pacific on Saturday during Homecoming Weekend. Kickoff is scheduled for 4 p.m.

Evergreen - The Geoducks have three big matches at home this week, starting Friday afternoon against College of Idaho. Evergreen will then host Oregon Tech on Saturday and Concordia on Tuesday.

Northwest - The Eagles look to rebound from their CC loss to Concordia over the weekend, but face tough competition in Oregon Tech and the College of Idaho at home this Friday and Saturday. NU defeated the Owls in overtime in Klamath Falls and this will be the first meeting with the Yotes this season who are tied with NU with 2-2 league records.
