Around The Cascade Conference

College of Idaho - Lady Yotes look to start a new win streak this weekend, hosting Warner Pacific and front-runner Concordia...Kilee Lopez had a career-high 35 digs in Friday win at OIT, with Kylie Porter adding a career-high 18 kills

Concordia - Concordia has used a diverse attack in 2014 with four different players averaging at least 2.4 kills per set. Junior Ashley Jibby leads the way with 2.71 kills per set and is followed closely by freshman Lindsey Dorsey (2.66 kps), junior Brianna Hogan (2.50 kps) and sophomore Brenna Huwe (2.45 kps).

Corban - After earning its first conference win this past week, Corban hosts Northwest Christian University on Friday night at 7 p.m. as a part of Homecoming weekend!

Eastern Oregon - The Eastern Oregon University volleyball team dropped one spot in the fourth edition of the Tachikara-NAIA Volleyball Coaches' Top 25 Poll this week. EOU came in as the No.12 team in the nation. Senior, Casey Loper ranks seventh in the nation in kills with 274 on the season.

Evergreen - The Geoducks return home for the first time in nearly three weeks as they play host to Oregon Tech on Friday night and 13th-ranked Southern Oregon on Saturday. The Geoducks are the third-best hitting team in the conference, attacking at a .202 clip.

Northwest - The Eagles are at home this weekend and host #13 Southern Oregon and Oregon Tech in the NU Pavilion. NU has won 9 matches this season, two better than their entire season last year.

Northwest Christian - Last weekend Kayla Ping scored 23 kills against Northwest, the most by a Beacon in four years. Chelsea McGowan also hit a career-high 16 kills and Alyssa Dorr broke her personal best with 51 assists. Dorr also collected her 916th career assist, moving into third place in the Beacon's record book.

Oregon Tech - The Oregon Tech volleyball team looks to end a two-match skid when the Owls travel to Washington to face Evergreen State College and Northwest University on Friday and Saturday. The Owls have dropped three of their last four conference matches.

Southern Oregon - Outside hitter Paulla Pinheiro and libero Brookelynn Cole swept CCC Player of the Week honors, and the Raiders moved up one spot to No. 13 in the NAIA rankings following their wins over league favorites Eastern Oregon and College of Idaho last weekend. Pinheiro is at 81 kills and 49 digs in her last five matches. Cole collected 50 digs over the week and has helped the Raiders hold 11 straight opponents under a .200 hitting average.
