## Notes From Around The Cascade Conference

**College of Idaho-** Lady Yotes put four match win streak on the road against Eastern Oregon on Friday night...Sierra Porter earned CCC Defensive Player of the Week after a season-high three-set, 43 assist performance vs. Evergreen and 44 assist-20 dig match vs. Northwest.

**Concordia-** Through 18 matches, Concordia has played in only two five-set contests this year. The Cavs dropped both outings with a neutral-site loss to The Master's College on Aug. 22 and a defeat in the fifth set at home against NCAA DII Seattle Pacific on Aug. 29.

**Corban-** The Warriors host two games this weekend against Southern Oregon and Oregon Tech. Corban is looking to rebound from a tough two-loss road trip last week.

**Eastern Oregon-** The Eastern Oregon Volleyball Team is currently ranked No. 9 in the nation. This ties the highest ranking in program history. The Mountaineers enter this weekend's game against College of Idaho on a five game winning streak. EOU ranks sixth in the nation in assists per set (12.9) and seventh in kills per set (13.9).

**Evergreen-** Seeking to end a five-matching losing streak, the Geoducks host Concordia on Friday and Warner Pacific on Saturday. The squad plays five of its final seven Cascade Collegiate Conference matches on its home court.

**Northwest Christian-** With a win over Warner Pacific this weekend, NCU has put themselves in the drivers' seat for the sixth-and-final spot in the CCC post-season tournament. The Beacons are currently tied with the Knights at 3-8, but NCU swept the season series giving them the tie breaker.

**Northwest-** The Eagles are at home this weekend to open the second half of CCC play and will host Warner Pacific on Friday and Concordia on Saturday, two teams who defeated NU in Portland by identical 3-1 match scores in September.

**Oregon Tech-** The Oregon Tech volleyball team is looking for their first 20-win season since the 2008 season when the Owls travel to Northwest Christian and Corban this Friday and Saturday. Two wins in CCC action will keep the Owls in the hunt for a second-straight postseason berth.

**Southern Oregon-** Southern Oregon cracked the NAIA top-10 for the first time in 2014 this week, moving up for the sixth straight week. The Raiders had an eight-day break after their match last Wednesday at OIT, which they needed five sets to defeat for the second time this season. Paulla Pinheiro strengthened her all-star campaign with 20 kills and 15 digs -- recording 10 straight kills in the final two sets without an error.
