Notes From Around The Cascade Conference

College of Idaho- C of I meets fellow unbeaten Northwest on Thursday in a key CCC match-up...Saturday marks Senior Day for the Yotes three senior student-athletes

Concordia- Concordia is 26-1-2 all-time at Tuominen Yard, its on-campus stadium first used at the end of the 2011 season. The Cavaliers have outscored its opponents 71-7 at home over that span and have never conceded more than one goal in a match on its home pitch.

Corban- The Warriors play just one match this week vs. Northwest Christian University. Corban currently sits in sixth place in the conference standings.

Eastern Oregon- Eastern Oregon looks for its first conference win of the season this weekend when they host Evergreen and Northwest. Kaeliana De Vera leads the Mountaineers with three goals on the season.

Evergreen- The Geoducks take the momentum of a 3-0 rain-soaked home victory over Northwest Christian on the road for conference matches against Eastern Oregon on Thursday and College of Idaho on Saturday. In the win over NCU, Delaney Smith and Amy Bromley both had a goal and assisted on the other's tally. Bromley leads the team with four goals and 11 points, while Smith has a team-best four assists.

Northwest Christian- Senior Mishayla Bertelsen is making a historical impact as her career comes to a close. She has six assists this year which is one shy of the single-season record and also ties her for the Beacon career record with 13. She also ranks fourth all-time for goals (10) and third all-time for points (33).

Northwest- The league-leading Eagles face a tough test this week when they travel to Caldwell for a meeting with the College of Idaho on Thursday. The Yotes are in third place, but are undefeated with a 3-0-2 record which includes a big win over 2nd place Concordia last week. Saturday, the Eagles will be in La Grande for a game with Eastern Oregon for another key CCC game.

Oregon Tech- The Oregon Tech women's soccer team has come close in two of the past four outings, including a pair of double-overtime ties, but is still looking for a win in CCC action with a game at Warner Pacific College this Thursday in Portland.

Southern Oregon- The Raiders went unbeaten in two straight matches for the first time this season last week, using Megan McArthur's goal to top Eastern Oregon and Haylee Eckart's to tie College of Idaho. They'll be on the road for their last three regular season contests, starting this week at Concordia and Warner Pacific.
