## Notes From Around The Cascade Conference

**College of Idaho-** College of Idaho heads to Portland this weekend for big matches at Concordia and Warner Pacific with third-place in the CCC on the line...the 34-32 Set 1 score on Friday at Eastern Oregon was the highest by a C of I team in the 25-point rally scoring era.

**Concordia-** Joining EOU's returning All-American Casey Loper, Concordia freshman hitter Lindsey Dorsey is just one of two players in the CCC ranked inside the top 10 in hitting percentage (No. 9, .267) and kills per set (No. 8, 3.09 k/s).

**Corban-** Corban travels to Northwest Christian University on Friday before hosting New Hope Christian College on Saturday night.

**Eastern Oregon-** The Eastern Oregon University volleyball team improved to No. 8 in the Tachikara-NAIA Volleyball Coaches' Top 25 Poll. This is the highest ranking for EOU in the Coaches' Top 25 Poll. The Mountaineers recorded their sixth straight win on Friday, Oct. 17 with a sweep of College of Idaho.

**Evergreen-** With 12 wins to its credit this season, the 2014 Evergreen volleyball team is within two wins of tying the program's single-season record for victories. The 2003 team finished 14-13 overall (.538 winning percentage), which is the only winning record in Evergreen volleyball history. The Geoducks have six games remaining on their schedule, four at home, including a Wednesday non-conference contest against St. Martin's.

**Northwest Christian-** The Beacons got a split last weekend, knocking off Oregon Tech for the seventh time in their last nine games. The result leaves them in a tie for sixth-place while holding the tiebreaker over Northwest University for the sixth-and-final playoff spot with five matches remaining in the regular season.

**Northwest-**

**Oregon Tech-** The Oregon Tech volleyball team will host Northwest and Evergreen this weekend, with a pair of wins keeping a postseason berth within reach. A road split last week gave the Owls their 20th victory of the season.

**Southern Oregon-** The 11th-ranked Raiders return home this weekend toting a seven-match win streak after completing a five-match road swing with sweeps at Corban and Northwest Christian last weekend. Lauren McGowne, the CCC leader in assists, was named the offensive player of the week for her 69 assists in six sets, raising her average to 11.4 in league matches. Motade Atanda had 32 kills and ranks second in the CCC in that category.

**Warner Pacific-** Setter Marchelle Bostic is just 16 assists away from reaching 2,000 for her career at Warner Pacific.
