## Notes From Around The Cascade Conference

**College of Idaho-** Lady Yotes clinch a postseason berth with a victory in one of their final two games of the season (at Corban, at Northwest Christian)...the four draws by C of I are the most since the 1995 season.

**Concordia-** Junior goalkeeper Nicole Franklin ranks fifth in NAIA with a 0.43 goals against average and the Concordia women are tied for ninth in the nation with a team 0.53 GAA. The Cavs have allowed just eight goals in 15 matches this season.

**Corban-** Corban hosts The College of Idaho on Thursday before playing its Senior Day match vs. Eastern Oregon on Saturday. Kickoffs are set for 3 p.m. and 1 p.m., respectively.

**Eastern Oregon-** The Mountaineers closed out their 2014 regular season home schedule last weekend. The Mountaineers currently hold a 3-6-4 overall and 1-3-3 in CCC action. EOU heads to Corban and Northwest Christian this Thursday and Friday.

**Evergreen-** Evergreen, still mathematically in the running for one of the six CCC postseason tournament spots, plays its final two matches of the regular season at home against second-place Concordia on Thursday and third-place Warner Pacific on Saturday.

**Northwest Christian-** The Beacons (6-10) need just one more win to tie the school record for victories in the season. They had 7 wins during the 2012 season.

### **Northwest-**

**Oregon Tech-** The Oregon Tech women's soccer team dropped a pair of road contests last week and has just one more game remaining in the season, versus rival Southern Oregon this Saturday, to earn a win in CCC play this year.

**Southern Oregon-** With road losses at Concordia and Warner Pacific, the Raiders were officially taken out of contention for a home playoff match over the weekend. A win Saturday would still get them in the postseason for the fifth straight season.

**Warner Pacific-** A playoff berth is within reach after wins over OIT and SOU last week. The Knights are assured of their first ever winning record in CCC play with two games remaining.
