Notes From Around The Cascade Conference

College of Idaho- Lady Yotes clinched their 10th all-time playoff appearance on Friday and will host Warner Pacific on Wednesday in the CCC quarterfinals.

Concordia- Since 1996, the Concordia women's soccer team has never finished lower than second in the CCC standings. Concordia has compiled a 22-0 record in the last 11 years at the CCC Tournament. The Cavaliers have played two overtime contests over that span and have outscored its opponents 68-5.

Corban- Corban takes a break from action this week while preparing to host Southern Oregon next Wednesday in a CCC Tournament Quarterfinal match.

Eastern Oregon- EOU concluded its 2014 women's soccer season with a record of 3-8-1.

Evergreen- Evergreen concluded its season last Saturday with a 3-2 double-overtime victory over playoff participant Warner Pacific. Irina Lyons scored all three goals for the Geoducks and became the first Evergreen player to register a hat trick since the 2006 season. Lyons was named CCC Offensive Player of the Week.

Northwest Christian- The Beacons closed out one of the most successful campaigns in school history, tying the school win record (7) while coming within two goals of an all-time single-season best.

Northwest- The Eagles have a chance to rest and recover from injuries as they played the final five games without the services of at least two starters each game. Head coach Val Seid is also recovering from back surgery this week and was unable to travel with the team in their final two road games, so earning the first round bye was significant for the entire team and coaching staff.

Oregon Tech-

Southern Oregon- SOU will be making its fifth straight postseason appearance after Saturday's 5-1 win at Oregon Tech, which was its highest-scoring match of the season led by Megan McArthur's two goals. The Raiders are 4-1 this season when they score more than one goal.
