Notes From Around The Cascade Conference

College of Idaho- Yotes completed a big home sweep of Warner Pacific and Concordia, as Sierra Porter averaged over 13 assists per set in the wins.

Concordia- Not only did Eastern Oregon's 3-0 win over Concordia on Friday snap a nine-match winning streak for Concordia, but the loss was just the second sweep handed to the Cavaliers this season. In the second match of the year, Concordia fell 3-0 to Montana Tech to open play at the Biola Summer Slam on August 21.

Corban- Corban is riding a two-match winning streak after topping Northwest Christian on Friday evening in four sets. The Warriors will look to continue their recent hot-streak when they travel to Concordia and Warner Pacific on Friday and Saturday.

Eastern Oregon-The Mountaineers come in at No. 10 in the fifth edition of the Tachikara-NAIA Volleyball Coaches' Top 25 Poll. Casey Loper became the second player in Eastern Oregon University history to record 1,000 career kills. She recorded her 1,000 kill against Warner Pacific, last Saturday.

Evergreen- The Geoducks take their 11-11 overall record and 2-7 CCC mark on the road for contests at College of Idaho on Friday and Eastern Oregon on Saturday.

Northwest Christian- At the end of the first half of the CCC schedule, NCU is one of five teams that are tied for sixth place. With the top-six making the Cascade Conference post-season tournament, a lot will be riding on each game between those deadlocked schools. The Beacons will face one of them on Friday when they travel to Warner Pacific. NCU defeated the Knights in the first half of the season, 3-0 behind 11 kills apiece from Chelsea McGowan and Chandler Gabrio.

Southern Oregon- SOU is unbeaten since 2001 at Danny Miles Court but figures to take a more strenuous test than usual on Wednesday at OIT. The teams' first matchup of the season went five sets in Ashland, ultimately becoming SOU's 22nd consecutive win in the series. The Raiders are currently second in the NAIA at 2.98 blocks per set, and Motade Atanda led the attack with 51 kills last weekend to garner CCC Red Lion Offensive Player of the Week kudos for the second time this season.
