Notes From Around The Cascade Conference

College of Idaho – Lady Yotes will have the weekend off after an 0-4 start to the season (all against NAIA Division I teams – which CCC squads are 1-10 against this season)

Concordia – None submitted

Corban – The Warriors take to the road this week to play three Montana schools over the weekend. Corban will play MSU Northern (Mont.) on Friday, the University of Great Falls (Mont.) on Saturday, and Carroll College (Mont.) on Sunday.

Evergreen – After an 11-day competitive break, the Geoducks return to action this weekend at the Northwest-Evergreen Challenge hosted by Northwest University. Evergreen plays Simpson and Walla Walla. The next home contest for the Geoducks is Nov. 25 when New Hope Christian comes to Olympia.

Eastern Oregon – The Mountaineers improved to 4-0 on Sunday after a 93-40 victory over Walla Walla University. Nikki Osborne finished the game with 17 points and 10 rebounds for a double-double. Kassy Larson added 13 points. EOU returns to action on Saturday, Nov. 15 when they travel to Spokane, Wash. to play Whitworth University.

Northwest Christian –

Northwest – The first annual Northwest/Evergreen Challenge gets under way Friday when NU and the Geoducks will play Simpson and Walla Walla in the NU Pavilion. NU plays Walla Walla and Evergreen takes on Simpson on Friday afternoon and then switch opponents on Saturday evening.

Oregon Tech – The Oregon Tech women's basketball team will take a 6-0 mark to San Francisco State in an exhibition game on Saturday, November 15. The Owls resume regular season play on Tuesday, November 18th versus New Hope Christian at Danny Miles Court.

Southern Oregon – The Raiders won two exhibition games last week against NCAA Division II opponents Regis University and Metro State in Denver. Carly Meister had a career night against Regis with 33 points on 16-for-20 shooting, and was named to all-tournament team along with Ashley Claussen and Kristen Schoenherr. The Raiders return home this weekend against Pacific Union.

Warner Pacific – WPC earned their first win of the season last week versus Multnomah. Jordan Wilcox leads the CCC with 19 three pointers made.
