Notes From Around The Cascade Conference

College of Idaho – Lady Yotes return to action this week, meeting rival NNU in a Wednesday exhibition, before traveling to Lewiston to meet No. 15 Lewis-Clark State and New Hope Christian.

Concordia – None submitted

Corban – Corban travels on Wednesday to play Lewis & Clark College, and then plays Portland State University in an exhibition on Saturday in Portland.

Evergreen – None submitted

Eastern Oregon – The Eastern Oregon University Men's Basketball team fell in their first exhibition game of the season, as they were defeated by the University of Idaho, 77-65. Bryan McGriff led the way for the Mountaineers with 27 points.

Northwest Christian – The Beacons are back in action on Wednesday night for the first time in over a week. NCU is currently led by junior transfer Demarea Caples, averaging 13 points and 7.7 rebounds per game with eight blocks and six steals through three games.

Northwest – NU takes a week off from play and will host their annual alumni game this Friday at 5:30 p.m. and welcomes back a number of former players. They resume play on Nov. 28 when they travel to Bellingham to take part in the Lynda Goodrich Classic at Western Washington University.

Oregon Tech – The Oregon Tech women, coming off an exhibition loss at San Francisco State (73-66), take a perfect 6-0 mark up against New Hope Christian College Tuesday night, for the second time this season. The Owls defeated the Deacons by a 69-36 decision in Ashland. The Lady Owls host the Midland Empire Insurance Classic this Friday and Saturday with games versus William Jessup and Cal Maritime. Tess Armstrong leads Tech in scoring at 15.9 points and is pulling down 6.8 boards per game. Megan Whetstone is leading the Owls with 7.7 caroms.

Southern Oregon – The Raiders put four players in double figures for the fourth time in five games and are now 5-0 for the third time in four years after their 69-56 win Tuesday at Simpson. Kristen Schoenherr and Autumn Durand had 17 points apiece to lead the way, and Alexi Smith has hit 10 points in every game.

Warner Pacific – WPC heads to Lewiston, Idaho this weekend for a tournament, and will face New Hope Christian and Lewis-Clark State.
