## Notes From Around The Cascade Conference

**College of Idaho** – Lady Yotes gave head coach Mark Owen his first win as skipper, topping New Hope Christian on Saturday...C of I hosts the Best Western Lady Yote Classic this weekend, welcoming in Westminster, Whitworth, and Eastern Oregon.

**Concordia** – The Cavaliers hit 17 of 26 from 3-point range (65.4 percent) in a 98-30 blowout over Multnomah on Tuesday. Guards Sierra Dean, Briannah Smith and Janae Klarich combined to hit 13 of 22 from distance.

**Corban** – None submitted

**Evergreen** – Evergreen is off to a 4-0 start following a 79-58 Tuesday night home victory over New Hope Christian.

**Eastern Oregon** – The Mountaineers return to action on Friday, Nov. 28 as they take on Whitworth in the Caldwell Best Western Inn and Suites Lady Yote Classic. Last week, EOU went 2-0 with victories over Walla Walla, 110-36, and Simpson, 88-52. EOU leads the NAIA in assists per game, as they average 22.6 assists per game.

**Northwest Christian** – Sami Pitts is currently leading the CCC and ranks seventh in the NAIA, shooting 53% from three-point range. The Beacons are set to host winless Walla Walla on Saturday. NCU is 8-0 all-time against the Wolves, winning by an average margin of 44 points per game.

**Northwest** – The Northwest U women will be in Bellingham this weekend taking part in the 18th Annual Lynda Goodrich Classic which takes place in Sam Carver Gymnasium on the Western Washington Univ. campus. NU will play two NCAA D-II opponents in St. Martin's on Friday and the tourney host, WWU on Saturday night.

**Oregon Tech** – None submitted

**Southern Oregon** – The 21st-ranked Raiders are 7-0 for the third time in four seasons and off until a Dec. 2 exhibition at San Jose State. Alexi Smith (13.7), Autumn Durand (13.5), Carly Meister (13.0) and Kristen Schoenherr (12.8) are all scoring in double figures.
