Notes From Around The Cascade Conference

College of Idaho- The Lady Yotes saw their eight-year run as CCC regular-season champion come to a close after a road loss at Concordia on Nov. 24...C of I will still try to run their string of CCC tournament finals to nine next week (Yotes have played for – or won – every CCC Tournament title since 2005)

Concordia- One game back of the conference co-leaders, Concordia will be playing for a first-round bye in the CCC Tournament this week by finishing the regular season at Southern Oregon and Oregon Tech. The Cavs defeated SOU 3-1 and OIT 3-0 in Portland in mid-September.

Corban- None submitted

Eastern Oregon- EOU volleyball come in at No. 11 in the latest Tachikara-NAIA Volleyball Coaches' Top 25 Poll, which was announced on Tuesday. The Mountaineers defeated then-No. 11 Southern Oregon last Saturday. The Win moved EOU into a tie for the top spot in the CCC. Rachelle Chamberlain and Jessalyn Smith were named CCC Red Lion Offensive and Defensive Volleyball Player of the Week.

Evergreen- Two home losses stopped Evergreen's late-season run toward a playoff spot, so the Geoducks wrap up their season at home Friday night against Northwest.

Northwest Christian- The Beacons will look to overcome some tie-breaker difficulties this weekend as they fight with Northwest and Oregon Tech for the final two playoff spots. NCU will need a win over #11 Eastern Oregon or a first-ever win over The College of Idaho to secure a third consecutive post-season appearance.

Northwest- NU wraps up their regular season at Olympia on Friday night with Evergreen. The Eagles need a victory to help their chances in landing a spot in the CCC Championships.

Oregon Tech- None submitted

Southern Oregon- The Raiders won in five Friday at College of Idaho for the second straight year, but had their 10-match win streak snapped Saturday in La Grande as Eastern Oregon forged a first-place tie. The Raiders can still clinch a share of their first regular-season title since 2010 by passing two more big tests -- Friday against Concordia, and Saturday against Warner Pacific at Riehm Arena. They're 7-0 at home this season.
